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RE: Billing for Immune Globulin (RHIG)

This bulletin is to clarify Nebraska Medicaid's policy regarding Immune Globulin (RHIG).

Nebraska DHHS Division of Medicaid and Long-Term Care is federally mandated to collect rebates for Medicaid and Medicare crossover claims. Medicaid requires that providers report accurate National Drug Codes (NDCs) and associated units on submitted claims.

Immune Globulin (RHIG), full dose and mini dose, is rebatable and reimbursable only when submitted as follows:

J2790	Hyperrho S-D syringe (full dose)
J2791	Rhophylac 300 mcg/2 ml syringe (full dose)
J2788	Hyperrho S-D syringe (mini dose)

RhoGam billed under CPT codes 90384 and 90385, or by revenue code when on hospital claim, is not rebatable and therefore will not be covered by Nebraska Medicaid beginning June 1, 2012.
