

**Nebraska Department of Health & Human Services
Chronic Renal Disease Program**

**Reimbursable Drug Formulary
Effective: February 1, 2016**

The Renal Program reimburses for generics only – unless there is not a generic available. If that's the case, "Only Brand" will be listed in the "Currently Available" column. Exceptions are noted with * or ** and are defined at the end of the list.

If the Program client has prescription drug insurance coverage, the Program reimburses the portion that is the client's responsibility.

If the Program client doesn't have prescription drug insurance coverage, the reimbursement amount is based on the Medicaid fee for service allowable cost, plus a Program dispensing fee. Any remaining cost after the Program has paid is the client's responsibility.

Invoices are submitted to primary insurance providers first (private, Medicare and Medicaid). The Renal Program is the payer after all other insurances have paid their share.

Medications are listed in alpha order by Generic Name.
