This award recognizes a Community Health Worker who works directly with clients through home- or community-based services. Please note that credentialed/licensed health workers (e.g., nurses, physicians, physician's or nurse's assistant) are eligible for the Service Provider Award, but are not the target group for this award. Individuals working under titles such as navigators, home visitors, promotora, or other front-line workers are eligible for this award. Factors taken into consideration include the range of activities engaged in to promote health knowledge and self-sufficiency; provides compassionate and caring outreach on a continuing basis; strength of the relationship with their target community(ies); level of impact in their target community(ies); status as a role model to racial/ethnic minorities; and dedication to improving the lives and health status of racial/ethnic minority communities.
