

LAWFUL PRESENCE IN THE UNITED STATES ATTESTATION

As of October 1, 2009, any **individual** applying for initial licensure or renewing a Family Child Care Home I, Family Child Care Home II, Child Care Center or Preschool must attest to their lawful presence in the United States in order to comply with Nebraska Revised Statutes, §§4-108 through 4-114. This **does not** apply to Corporations or LLC's – Limited Liability Companies.
