


Governor-Designated Eligible Areas for Medicare Certified Rural Health Clinics

Eligible areas on this map represent 31 percent of population and 93 percent of the geographic area.

Only "new" Medicare Certified Rural Health Clinics are required to be located in a federal eligible area which has been updated in the past three years. The qualifying designations are: Governor Eligible Areas, Federal Primary Care Health Professional Areas or Federal Medically Underserved Areas.
