

## Ryan White Part B Program

### *Policy - Income Eligibility Guidelines 2010-2011*

Federal Policy Reference: Ryan White CARE Act (PL 104-146) Section 2618 (b)(1)(iv)(II).

***The Nebraska Ryan White Program has waived all requirements for subgrant entities regarding imposition of charges for services, pursuant to Section 2617(c)(4)(A) of the Ryan White Modernization Act of 2006.***

**Purpose:** The purpose of the Ryan White Part B policy on Direct Emergency Assistance is to ensure compliance with applicable Federal policies for the determination of income eligibility for clients applying for Ryan White Part B assistance.

1. Clients applying for Ryan White Part B assistance must have an income from wages (adjusted earned income) that equals no more than 200% of the Federal Poverty Level\* as established on April 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. Guidelines for the current grant year: Gross ***earned\*\**** income for the purposes of the Ryan White Program is to be reduced by 20% to cover mandatory taxes and withholding (***this applies to earned income only***).

The column on the left is the maximum income a person can earn before taxes are taken out and be eligible for Ryan White Part B services, the center column is the maximum income a person can earn annually before taxes are taken out, and the right column is the amount that is 200% of the FPL.

## Ryan White Part B Program

**If a client who has had income is suddenly without income due to illness, job termination or other circumstance, eligibility for DEA will be determined based on the period of no income.**

This table is for individuals who are not employed and have no taxes, FICA or Medicare tax taken from their income. The column on the left is the maximum monthly income that a person can make and be eligible for Ryan White Part B services. The column on the right is the maximum annual income that a person can make and be eligible for Ryan White Part B services.
