

## AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP)

The AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) provides medications to low-income individuals in all 50 States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and Guam who are infected with HIV disease. Qualified individuals have limited or no coverage under Medicaid, Medicare, or private insurance which may provide access to medications for the treatment of HIV disease.

As of October 23, 2013, Nebraska's ADAP formulary includes approximately 120 medications including medications currently approved by the FDA for the treatment of HIV disease. In addition to Federal funding, ADAP receives an additional State funding for HIV medications. The UNMC acts as the ADAP provider for Nebraska. Qualified individuals statewide receive medications either through walk-in pharmacy services at the hospital or through a mail order system.
