**Federal Requirements** A. Federal requirements, not specific to the WIC Program, which must be addressed in the local agency agreement include:

1. 7 CFR 3016, Uniform Administrative Requirements for Grants and Cooperative Agreements with State and Local Governments
2. 7 CFR 3017, Governmentwide Debarment and Suspension (Nonprocurement) and Governmentwide Requirements for drug-free Workplace (Grants)
3. 7 CFR 3018, New Restrictions on Lobbying
4. Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42 U.S.C. §2000 d et seq., as amended)
5. Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 (20 U.S.C. §1681 et seq.
6. §504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. §794)
7. Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1975 (42 U.S.C. §621 et seq.)
8. The Americans with Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. §12101, et seq., as amended)
9. Implementing regulations for 4-8 above.
