Because of the low incidence of TB in Nebraska, providers often lack experience in managing complex cases of TB due to the infrequency of encounters with this disease. This webinar will review some complex cases to help educate providers on the management of complex TB patients. Tuberculosis case management not only involves medical care, but partnerships between the local health department and infection control team to identify complete case management and public health duties.

At the conclusion of this activity, the participant should be better able to:

- Identify Infection Control concerns when dealing with infectious pulmonary TB patients
- Define potential causes and care for patients with slow sputum smear conversions
- Describe the process of doing a large contact investigation
