

2018 Competitive RFA Questions

1. **Question: Should we write the work plan for a 1 year period or for a 3 year period?**

Answer: The Grantee, NE DHHS has applied for a three year grant. Perspective subrecipients should write work plans for a one year period. Selected subrecipients will be asked to submit an updated budget and work plan for fiscal year two (September 1, 2019 – August 31, 2020 and fiscal year three (September 1, 2020 – August 31, 2021).

2. **Question: What is the definition of a Satellite Clinic?**

Answer: (See Attachment A of the RFA). While you can request money for Title X services provided off site, a Satellite clinic must be “open daily with a regular clinic schedule at a permanent facility,” to be considered for the additional \$10, 000.

3. **Question: In the Budget Narrative, do we include the \$40,000 and the \$10,000 per site?**

Answer: Complete a budget for the amount that you will use to implement Title X services. See Attachment A. Primary sites in a community with a population greater than 25,000 and who, request more than \$40,000 will receive \$40,000 as a base allocation. For additional sites (of the same agency) “open daily with a regular clinic schedule, permanent facility,” will receive an additional \$10,000. After that, “funds will be allocated based on the percent of unduplicated Family Planning Users 150% and below HHS Poverty Guidelines to Total Agency Users.”

4. **Question: What was changed in the Amended RFA and the Amended Attachments?**
