Subject: IMPORTANT – ACIP Recommendations for Adults

The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices has recommended a couple of changes to some adult vaccines. Information here is provided as a quick overview, in case your clinic gives vaccines to adults. Also, refer to the package insert on any new vaccines that you give.

## New shingles vaccine Shingrix

Shingrix is preferred because of better immune response

Should be given to people ages 50 and older, including those that already received Zostavax Given as 2 doses spaced 2-6 months apart

Stored in the refrigerator

Vaccine is reconstituted

Given IM

Increase in expected reactions - pain, myalgia, fatigue

Symptoms typically go away in 2 to 3 days

1 in 6 people may have reaction that interferes with daily activities

Having a reaction with first dose, does not strongly predict a reaction with the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose

Minimum spacing between Zostavax and Shingrix is 8 weeks.

## New hepatitis B vaccine Heplisav-B

New 2 dose Hepatitis B vaccine for those ages 18 years and older 2 dose series given one month apart

Given IM
