To: All VFC, AIP & Birthdose Hospital Providers

When receiving shipments of VFC and AIP vaccine, accepting the NESIIS inbound transfer after you have received the vaccine shipment, should be part of your same day protocol. Accepting the inbound transfer automatically enters received vaccine into your inventory. VFC & AIP Vaccine should never be entered into your inventory manually, unless instructed to do so.

Also, remember to email your Community Health Nurse regarding expiring vaccine:

- **Vaccine close to expiration:**
 - Notify your assigned Community Health Nurse **3-6 months prior** to vaccine expiring for any vaccine that the clinic can't use up before expiration
 - NDHHS may try to transfer vaccine to another clinic before expiration
 - Copies of temperature logs must accompany any vaccine transfer
 - Adjust ordering patterns as needed to prevent overstock of vaccine
