

To obtain licensure in the State of Nebraska as a Basic Life Support or an Advanced Life Support Emergency Medical Service you must:

1. Submit a Complete [Application](#);
2. Submit a list of the names, license numbers and licensure levels of the members/employees of the service;
3. Submit a description or map of its service area;
4. Submit a completed [Physician Medical Director Authorization](#);
5. Submit a written agreement with a licensed emergency medical service if the applicant does not own or lease an ambulance;
6. If the service has modified the Nebraska Emergency Medical Service Protocols, submit a copy of your modified protocols signed by your Physician Medical Director;
7. If applying for an Advanced Life Support Service license, submit a copy of the completed application for a [Mid-Level Practitioner Controlled Substance Registration](#) (DEA Number); and
8. If the service will be using a glucose monitor, submit a copy of the current [Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments](#) (CLIA) certificate or a copy of the completed application for a CLIA certificate.

Upon receipt of all the required documents, the Department will forward the application to the Board of Emergency Medical Services. The Board will then schedule an inspection within 15 working days.
