

SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM-ADVISING SHEET

The Surgical Technology program at Southeast Community College – Lincoln Campus accepts students every third quarter. Acceptance to the program is contingent upon the successful completion of the nine (9) prerequisite courses listed below. These courses may be taken at any college. If you have questions about courses from another college being equivalent to SCC courses, please contact the Registration office. To take the prerequisite courses at Southeast Community College, please apply to the Pre-health program.

Students have the following options when enrolling in the program (you must choose an option when applying):

Option 1 – Clinical in Lincoln with face-to-face program courses

Option 2 – Clinical outside of Lincoln with program courses online. Students will be required to travel to Lincoln for lab. (Option 2 is not available for students who have a Lincoln address. You are eligible to apply for the core Surgical Technology program once you are registered for your final quarter/semester of the prerequisite courses or if you have already completed the prerequisite courses listed below. To apply, you must submit the following documents to the Admissions office:

- New paper application for the Surgical Technology program
- Program-Advising Sheet
- Class schedule showing enrolled classes (if taken somewhere other than SCC)
- Clinical site **only if** choosing option 2 (example: Norfolk, NE) _____
- Transcripts from high school or GED and other colleges (if applicable)

If you have taken ANY of the required courses at another college, you must submit an official copy of your transcript. The transcript must be received by our office prior to submitting your documents. Have the transcript sent to SCC – Admissions Office, 8800 'O' Street, Lincoln, NE 68520.
