Five-Year Objectives	Strategies: Year Two (Oct. 1, 2016 – Sept. 30, 2017)
5a. By 2020, decrease child (age 0-9 years) injury due to motor vehicle crashes by 10% through increased proper use of appropriate-for-size child safety seats.	
5b. By 2020, increase the number and percentage of women (18-44) from baseline who always wear a seatbelt.	
5c. By 2020, decrease youth (age 10 – 16 years) injury due to motor vehicle crashes by 10% through increased seat belt use and decreased distracted driving, and recognizing risks of night/drowsy driving, speed, and alcohol use.
