COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

CLASS A – DIABETES AND DIABETIC PROBLEMS

(3 HOURS – MORNING)

Understand diabetes and types of diabetic problems involved in emergency response. Learn how to read blood glucose levels and the impact of inaccurate readings.

CLASS B – EPI PEN AND ALBUTEROL

(3 HOURS – AFTERNOON)

Recognize signs and contraindications for use of EPI-Pen and Albuterol Treatments. Learn the Nebraska Treatment Protocols for using these medications.

CLASS C – BARIATRIC PATIENT CARE FOR EMS PROVIDERS

Review challenges and issues handling morbidly obese patients. Understand patient care, packaging and transporting. Hands on demonstration of bariatric equipment and units, including cots and ambulance design.

CLASS D – BURN INJURY CLASS
