Child Abuse and Neglect Recognition: EMS Assessment and Treatment

Dr. Suzanne Haney is a Child Abuse Pediatrician with Children's Specialty Physicians. She has served as Medical Director at Project Harmony, a local non-profit organization focused on child abuse evaluation, education and prevention, since 2008. Dr. Haney is an Assistant Professor at University of Nebraska Medical Center and is the medical director of the Children's Advocacy Team at Children's Hospital & Medical Center.

Dr. Haney earned her medical degree from the University of Southern California and completed a residency in Pediatrics at Naval Medical Center, Portsmouth in Virginia. She spent 9 years as a physician in the Navy and has worked as a staff pediatrician at Naval Medical Center Portsmouth in Virginia and Department Head of Pediatrics at U.S. Naval Hospital in Yokosuka, Japan.

Dr. Haney completed her fellowship in Child Abuse Pediatrics at Eastern Virginia Medical School and Children's Hospital of the King's Daughters and is currently the only board-certified child abuse pediatrician in the state.

Dr. Haney will explain child abuse injuries, patient assessment, and the appropriate treatment and handling by EMS providers.
