NAICS 48-49




The transportation and warehousing sector includes industries providing transportation of passengers and cargo, warehousing and storage for goods, scenic and sightseeing transportation, and support activities related to modes of transportation. Establishments in these industries use transportation equipment or transportation related facilities as a productive asset. The type of equipment depends on the mode of transportation. The modes of transportation are air, rail, water, road, and pipeline.

Number of Injuries and Illnesses

In 2012, an estimated 2,200 total non-fatal injuries and illnesses occurred in Nebraska's private transportation and warehousing industry sector.

Annual number of injuries and illnesses in transportation and warehousing, Nebraska, 2008–2012



Rate of Injuries and Illnesses

In 2012, the estimated non-fatal injury/illness rate in Nebraska's private transportation and warehousing sector was 4.2 per 100 full-time workers, which was lower than the U.S. rate of 4.9 per 100 full-time workers.

Annual number of fatal occupational injuries in transportation and warehousing, Nebraska, 2008–2012

Year	Number
2008	7
2009	6
2010	10
2011	5
2012	7*

Out of **7*** fatal work injuries in the transportation and warehousing industry in 2012:

- 7 (100%) fatalities were men.
- 7 (100%) were wage and salary workers.
- Vehicles were a primary source of injury in 6 (86%) fatalities
- 6 (86%) were among workers with transportation and material moving occupations.
