

When will baby's teeth come in?

Usually baby teeth (primary teeth) start coming in around six months of age. All twenty primary teeth are usually in by age 2 1/2 to 3 years.

Signs of teething are:

- Sore gums
- More drooling
- Fussiness and irritability
- Chews on everything

When your baby is irritable from teething, let him/her chew on something cool and soothing, like a clean, cold washcloth or a teething ring.

Teething does not make a child sick. If your child has a fever or other serious symptoms, consult your pediatrician.
