

# PROVIDER UPDATE

## State Pap Plus Program Changes Effective 11-1-2015

Beginning November 1, 2015 paper claims will no longer be accepted for the State Pap Plus Program. Quick claims will be entered for all State Pap Plus reimbursements. The new Quick Claim section is located on Page 5 of the updated enrollment.

Providers serving over 50 clients will no longer be performing data entry. All enrollments and Quick Claims will be entered by EWM central office.

All providers must:

- Download State Pap Plus Enrollments from EWM Web site.
- Make sure Enrollments are properly filled out and sent to EWM within 2 weeks of date of service for timely data entry. Optional Enrollment check list attached.
  - Enrollments that are not properly filled out will be sent back to clinic for completion.
- Fill out the NEW Quick Claim section on Page 5 of the Enrollment. Paper claims will not be accepted.
  - Enrollments that do not have Quick Claim information filled out will be returned to clinics. Enrollments may be resubmitted after Quick Claim information is correctly filled out.

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### U.S. Preventative Services Task Force (USPSTF) Cervical Guidelines:

It is now recommended that cervical cancer screening begin at 21 years of age, regardless of sexual activity or other risk factors.

Screening with cytology is recommended every 3 years for women 21-29 years of age.

Women 30-39 years of age should be screened with cytology every 3 years or co-testing (cytology/HPV testing) every 5 years.

### Reimbursable Services Have NOT Changed.

#### Covered Services:

- Office Visit and Pap Test with Pelvic Exam
- Office visit only is covered when an STD test is performed for women and men 18+ at the Program Rate of \$25.00.
- General Clinic Services in conjunction with Pap Test or STD Testing
