

Emergency Medical Services Physician Medical Director Contract

Agreement for Physician Medical Director for City of **Good Life**, Nebraska Ambulance Service Emergency Medical Services Program

This agreement, made and entered into this 1st day of October, 2006, by and between the city of **Good Life**, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as "CITY" and **Dr. George W. Bush**, M.D., hereinafter referred to as "**Contractor**"

WHEREAS, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, Section 71-5183, requires "each licensed emergency medical service shall have a physician medical director"; and,

WHEREAS, CITY proposes to engage **the Contractor** to provide oversight and counsel in delivery of the emergency medical services (EMS) provided by **Good Life Ambulance Service personnel** in basic life support and advanced life support situations and this agreement sets forth the responsibilities of CITY and **Contractor** in this service and the position of Medical Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing terms and conditions set forth, the parties agree as follows:

Section 1. CITY agrees to appoint the **Contractor** as Physician Medical Director of the **Good Life** EMS program in accord with Section 71-5183, R.R.S., of Nebraska.

Section 2. The appointment of the **Contractor** shall be October 1, 2006 until September 30, 2009. This agreement may be extended for one year periods upon the review and mutual consent of CITY and **Contractor** through to September 30, 2011.

Section 3. CITY agrees to pay **Contractor** for services provided as Medical Director, and as an independent contractor with CITY, the sum of \$___ per month payable on or before the last day of each month during the term of this agreement, as set forth above and commencing with the month of November, 2006 and terminating September 30, 2009, unless extended in accord with Section 2 above.

Section 4. The **Contractor**, as Medical Director for **Good Life Ambulance Service**, agrees to provide services to CITY as follows:

- A. Review existing EMS protocols annually and develop and recommend new EMS protocols appropriate to the **Good Life Ambulance Service** in accord with state law. Protocols are expected to meet current standards for service delivery and patient care, as well as any that might be implemented during the term of this Agreement, for the citizens of **Good Life Ambulance District** and those for whom emergency medical services are provided.

- B. Oversee quality of services provided and prepare reports and studies as necessary to accomplish required EMS in accord with state law.
- C. Provide input to the **ambulance service** concerning purchases of equipment, supplies and vehicles.
- D. Oversee ongoing continuing education program of City Emergency Medical Technicians and Paramedics and make recommendations regarding the same to the Ambulance Director.
- E. Provide counsel and training for EMS personnel as appropriate to meet new responsibilities of the **Good Life Ambulance Service** as may from time to time be required, and as agreed to by the **Ambulance Director**.
- F. Meet quarterly, or as necessary, with ambulance personnel to review protocols and present topical issues and current best practices.
- G. Review records of service calls of EMS personnel to determine compliance with protocols, performance standards and regulations; recommend counseling and additional remedial training as necessary; and, recommend to the Ambulance Director disciplinary action for failure to comply with protocols, performance standards and regulations as directed.

Section 5. Either party may terminate this agreement upon providing the other party with ninety (90) days advance written notice.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed the foregoing Agreement as indicated above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF **GOOD LIFE**, NEBRASKA, that the attached Agreement appointing **George W. Bush**, M.D., as Medical Director for the **Good Life Ambulance Service** is approved and accepted. The Mayor is hereby authorized, directed and empowered to execute the same on behalf of the city.

This resolution shall repeal all resolutions or portions thereof in conflict herewith.
