

### NEBRASKA 2006 Statistical Report of Abortions

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### NEBRASKA ABORTIONS, 2006 Summary

This report presents tabulations of statistical information reported on records of induced abortions performed in Nebraska during calendar year 2006. These data are in compliance with specifications set forth in Nebraska Statute §28-343 through §28-346.

A total of 2,927 abortions were reported to the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services for 2006, a decrease of 7.8% when compared to the 2005 total of 3,173. The following chart shows the number of abortions performed; the percentage of abortions in different age groups; the mean and modal age of the patient; and the number of abortions per 1,000 live births since 1986.
