

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NEBRASKA 2022 Statistical Report of Abortions

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NEBRASKA ABORTIONS, 2022

Summary

This report presents tabulations of statistical information reported on records of induced abortions performed in Nebraska during calendar year 2022. These data are in compliance with specifications set forth in Nebraska Statute §28-343 through §28-345, §28-3,107 and §71-6909.

A total of 2,547 abortions were reported to the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services for 2022, an increase of approximately 7.92% when compared to the 2021 total of 2,360. The following chart shows the number of abortions performed; the percentage of abortions in different age groups; the mean and modal age of the patient; and the number of abortions per 1,000 live births since 2000.
