ORDER

- Defendant is found to be mentally incompetent to stand trial, and there is substantial probability the Defendant will become competent to stand trial within the foreseeable future.
- Defendant shall be committed to the Department of Health and Human Services to provide appropriate treatment to restore competency pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 83-109 and § 83-338. The Court shall hold a hearing within 60 days of this Order regarding Defendant's competency to stand trial and whether or not there is a substantial probability that the Defendant will become competent in the reasonably foreseeable future. DHHS shall submit an evaluation to this Court no more than 55 days from the date of this Order.
- DHHS is ordered to notify the court when the recommended treatment is available, and placement is appropriate. At such time, the court shall order transportation from [county jail] to LRC.
- Hearing is set for [date -within 60 days of the order].
