**SAMHSA PATH FY 2021 Mini-Application Deadline: Applications are due by May 3, 2021**

SAMHSA requires PATH recipients to submit a full two-year (i.e., biennial) application and in alternate years submit a mini-application. Accordingly, in FY 2021 states may submit the mini-application. In FY 2020, states submitted responses to narrative questions in the PATH Funding Opportunity Announcement that will not need to be updated for FY 2021 unless there has been a change in what was submitted in the FY 2020 application. For each narrative question, states will need to certify in the Web-based Block Grant Application System (WebBGAS) that the response provided in FY 2020 is still accurate for FY 2021. If not, the state will need to upload a FY 2021 updated response into WebBGAS for SAMHSA to review and approve.
