

## Mission

To distribute naloxone, a medication administered to counter the effects of an opioid overdose, to consumers either at risk themselves or know someone at risk for an opioid overdose *at no cost to the consumer or the pharmacy.*

## Eligibility

- Nebraska resident (a short assessment completed by recipient to ensure eligibility)
- Information verified by the pharmacist and naloxone entered into the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP)


