Once you complete your application, you will be directed to 'Your Confirmation' page which will show your confirmation number. This is proof that your application has been submitted.

iServe is also where you:

Healthcare

Healthcare/Medicaid

Health care services to eligible low-income adults, children, pregnant women, seniors and individuals with disabilities.

This application may also be used to determine eligibility for tax credits which can help to pay for health coverage premiums.

Helps with healthcare costs for people of all ages with low income. This includes:

- Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)
- Tax credits that can immediately help pay your premiums for health coverage, or
- Affordable private health insurance plans that offer comprehensive coverage to help you stay well.

Aged and disabled

Home and Community Based Services (HCBS)

Provides additional services and waivers for individuals with disabilities or those aged 65 and older. Waivers include Aged and Disabled (AD), Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI), and Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities (ID/DD). These help with:

- Arranging services at home or in the community
- · Support for daily activities
- Learning skills to be independent at home
- · Learning skills to get and maintain employment

*ID/DD services include the Family Support Waiver (FSW), Developmental Disabilities Adult Day Waiver (DDAD), and the Comprehensive Developmental Disabilities Waiver (CDD)
