


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Non-Medicaid Services

These services may be helpful if you have been found ineligible for Medicaid or an HCBS Waiver. Some services may also be used to supplement Medicaid services.

- **Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC)** provides services for Nebraskans 60 years or older, people with disabilities of all ages, family members, caregivers, and advocates.
- **Special Healthcare Needs Programs (SHCN)** provides programs to specific populations with special needs and their families.
- **Early Development Network (EDN)** provides services to children birth to age three, who are not developing typically or who have been diagnosed with a health condition that will affect their development.

Fill out the appropriate application.

Submit the application.

Personal Assistance Services (PAS)

- Assists individuals with a chronic medical condition or disability with activities of daily living, such as bathing or dressing.
- When applying for Medicaid, select the checkbox on the application that asks if you need assistance with activities of daily living.
- You also need to complete a SNA over the phone (after the application) by calling Nebraska Medicaid at (877) 667-6266.
- Before receiving services, the applicant needs to select a service provider for their PAS needs.

Active or pending Medicaid status.

Select the checkbox on the application for Needing Assistance with Activities of Daily Living. Or call Nebraska Medicaid to request PAS (800-383-4278).

Complete a Service Needs Assessment (SNA) over the phone.

Once all parts of eligibility are met, Medicaid services can begin.

Katie Beckett

- For eligible children with high levels of need who live in their parent's home.
- In addition to Medicaid eligibility criteria, children must meet one of the level of care criteria (hospital, nursing facility, or intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual disabilities).
- This is not a Medicaid waiver; it is a pathway to Medicaid eligibility.
- To apply, write your request for Katie Beckett on your Medicaid application or call Nebraska Medicaid at (800) 383-4270.

Apply for Nebraska Medicaid.

Meet the disability determination requirement.

Complete a Level of Care (LOC) Assessment.

Once all parts of eligibility are met, Medicaid services can begin.

HCBS Waivers


Applications can be completed through iServe or a paper application. To have a paper application mailed to you, call (877) 667-6266.

Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities

- Waivers in this category:
 - Family Support Waiver (birth – age 21)
 - Developmental Disabilities Adult Day Waiver (ages 21+)
 - Comprehensive Developmental Disability Waiver (all ages)
- Eligibility Criteria:
 - Meet Statutory Definition of a disability;
 - Be eligible for Nebraska Medicaid;
 - Meet Intermediate Care Facility (ICF) Level of Care; and
 - Have a need for waiver services.

Aged and Physical Disabilities

- Aged and Disabled Waiver (all ages)
 - Be eligible for Nebraska Medicaid;
 - Have a disability or be over the age of 65;
 - Meet Nursing Facility (NF) Level of Care; and
 - Have a need for waiver services.
- Traumatic Brain Injury Waiver (ages 18+)
 - Same requirements as the Aged and Disabled Waiver; and
 - Diagnosis of a traumatic brain injury.



* Waiver services cannot begin until Medicaid status is active.

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
