Onsite Provider Review (OPR)



Purpose of the OPR

The Onsite Provider Review aims to assess and ensure that the quality of Home and Community Based Services provided to waiver participants empowers the individual to live, love, learn, work, play, and pursue their dreams.



Role of the OPR Team

- Provide a 45-calendar day notice prior to Onsite occurring.
- Conduct interviews with participants and staff using a tool that is organized around Charting the LifeCourse domains.
- Conduct observations when appropriate.
- Compile data and enter it into the Quality Information Data System.
- Provide a Final Report to the Provider.
