 - a) We are working on a public/private investment into community-based preventions with he 23 Community Collaboratives located around the state. This will seek to provide services and supports directly to families outside of formal CPS system entry.
 - b) Family Finding Services have moved to be internally provided by DHHS-CFS.
 - c) Planning occurring around priority initiatives focused on our primary customer in the work that we do.
 - d) Drafting of the 2025 APSR and CFSP reports that will summarize the work being done in accordance with ACF requirements.

 - (1) Summer EBT is coming! DHHS and NDE are working with our federal partners. Once approval of the plan is received, additional information will be shared.
