# **Summary of Changes to DD HCBS Policy Manual**

The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) has revised the Developmental Disabilities (DD) Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Policy Manual.

# **Chapter 1 Introduction**

# **Chapter 2 Eligibility Entry into Services**

- 2.8 Waiver Participation Requirements
  - Added language speaking to the minimum frequency of services on the Family Support Waiver.

#### **Chapter 3 Participant Rights and Rights Restrictions**

- 3.6 Habilitation Programs and Behavior Support Plans
  - Added Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) to those who can complete assessments.
- 3.8 Emergency Safety Intervention
  - Updated language for the requirements of the agency rights review committee
- 3.10 Complaints
  - Added language regarding the participant's personal health information.
  - Added information about filing a complaint to DHHS.

#### **Chapter 4 Service Coordination**

No changes.

#### **Chapter 5 Person-Centered Planning and Implementation**

- 5.7 Annual Person-Centered Plan Meeting
  - Added clarifying language that providers are not required to complete certain standard assessments when an interRAI is complete.
- 5.11 Habilitation Programs
  - Updated language to Charting the LifeCourse.
  - Added APRN to Behavior Support Plans.

#### **Chapter 6 Self-Direction**

# **Chapter 7 Provider Requirements**

- 7.2 Agency Provider Requirements
  - Added Safety Plans and protocols to the records to be maintained.
  - Added language, including petty cash to participant finances and property.
  - Added guidance that notices need to be given in a language the participants understand.
  - Added clarifying language about agency responsibilities for documenting and providing documentation regarding the 15 days and requesting to bill other services.
  - Added clarifying language on where to submit written reports of investigations.
  - Added requirement for self-assessment to be completed due to a substantial change to the setting, such as changing footprint of the building or rebuilding after severe weather.
- 7.4 Virtual and Remote Supports as Modalities within Existing Services Provider Requirements
  - Updated language indicating the majority of each service provided weekly must be provided in-person.
