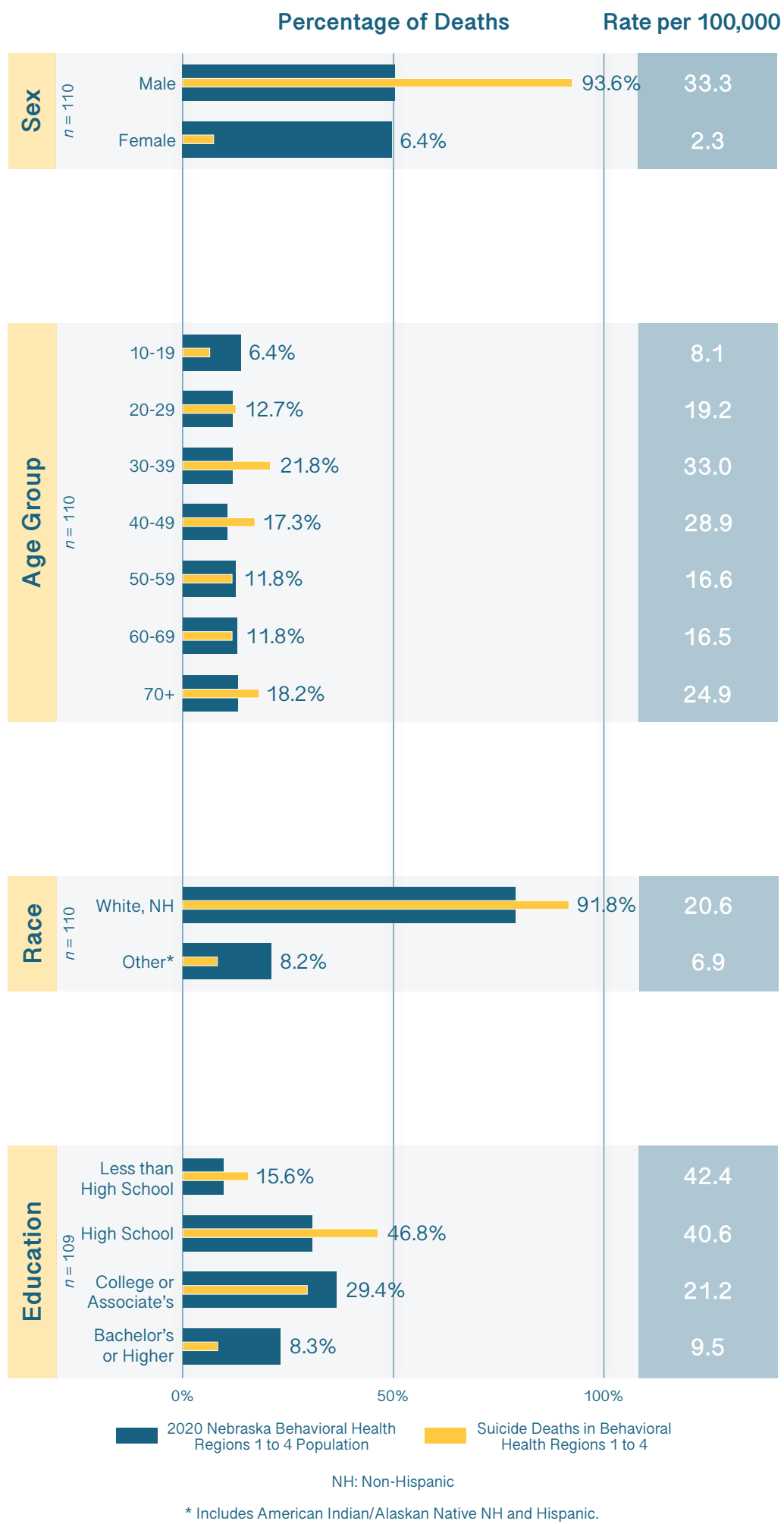


Summary of Suicide Deaths in Behavioral Health Regions 1 to 4 in Nebraska

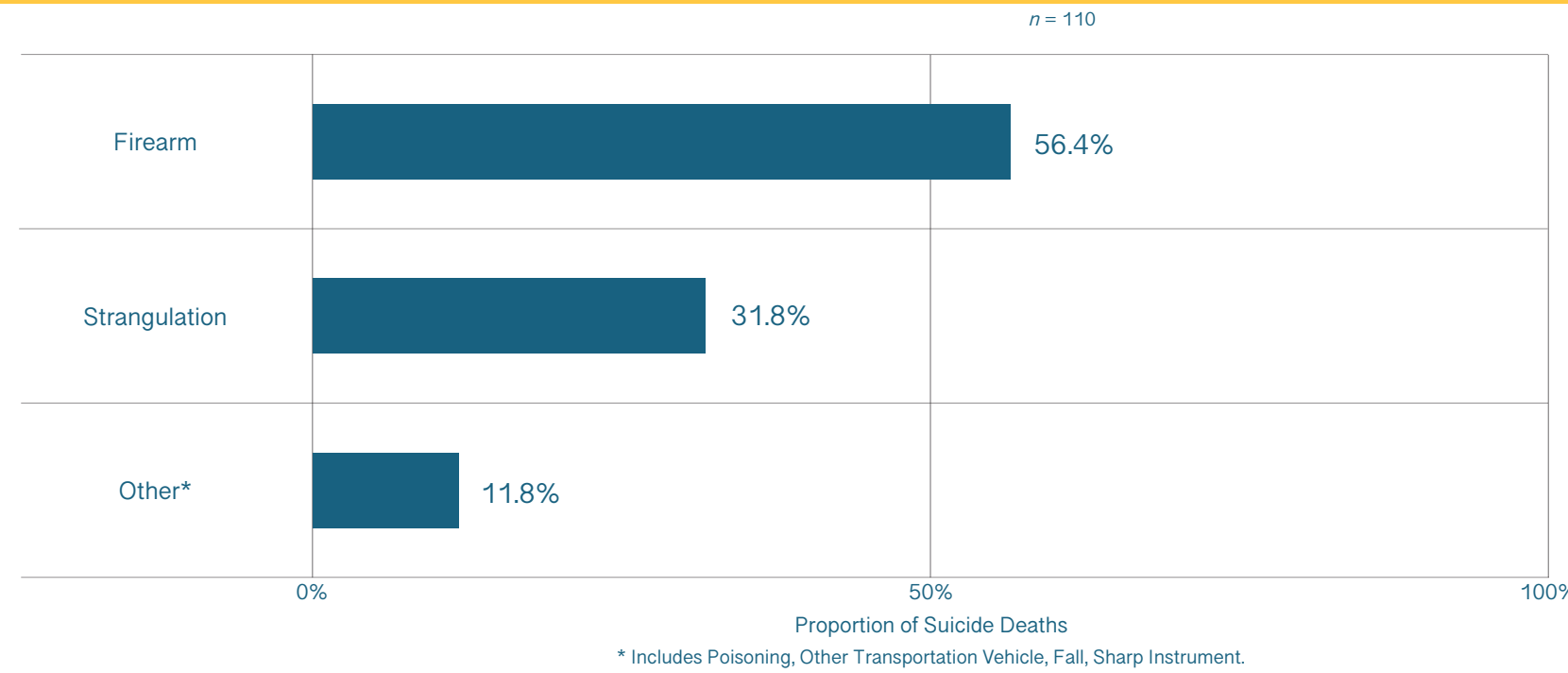

Demographic Information



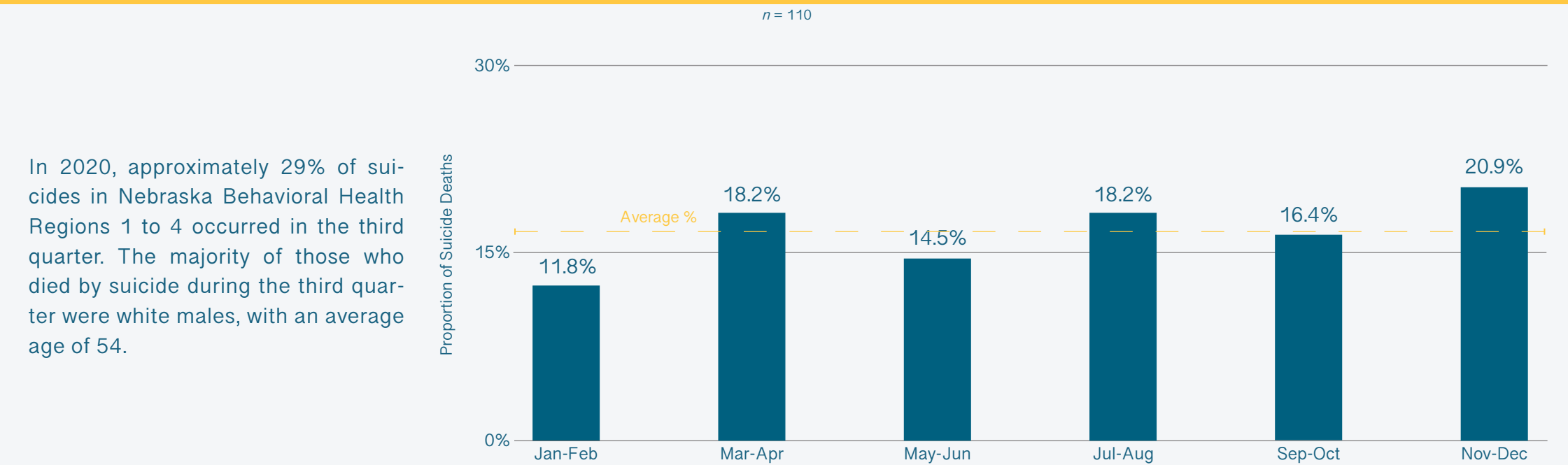
In 2020, male suicide victims were predominantly white males aged 30-39 with a high school education in Nebraska Behavioral Health Regions 1 to 4. The average age of male deaths was 48, while for females, it was 42.

Cause of Death



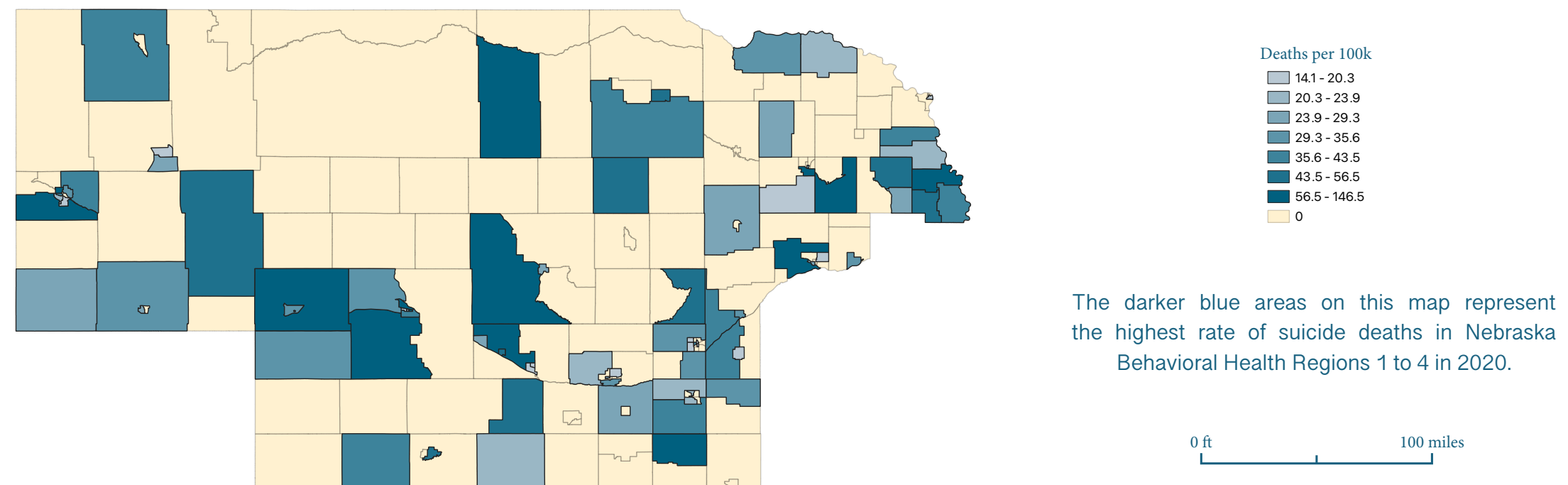
In 2020, firearms were the most common method of suicide among individuals in Nebraska Behavioral Health Regions 1 through 4, with an average age of 53. Strangulation had an average age of 41, while poisoning (including drug overdose) averaged 39. For females, poisoning (including drug overdose) was the most frequent method, with averaging at 52, strangulation at 29, and firearms at 53.

Suicide Deaths by Bimonthly



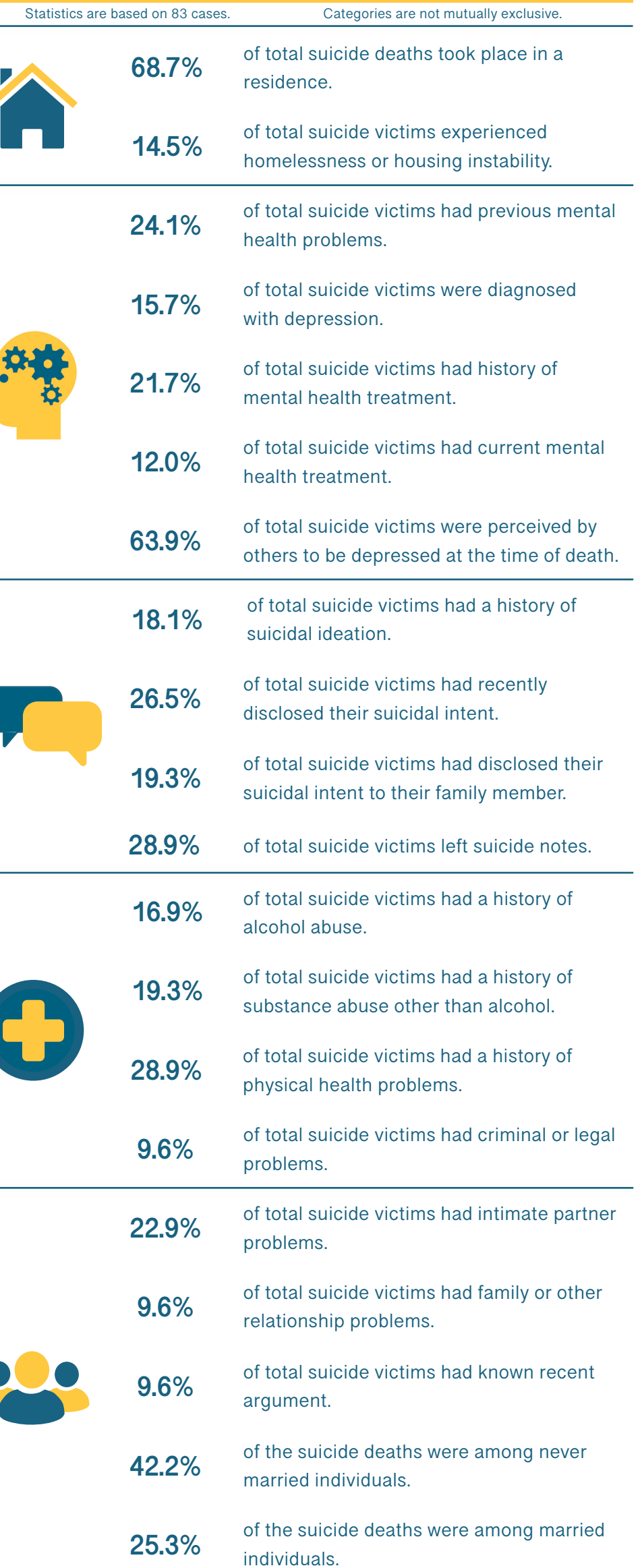
In 2020, approximately 29% of suicides in Nebraska Behavioral Health Regions 1 to 4 occurred in the third quarter. The majority of those who died by suicide during the third quarter were white males, with an average age of 54.
