

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


## What drugs were involved in Regions 1, 2, 3 and 4?



The top five drugs account for majority of all unintentional and undetermined intent drug overdose deaths in Region 1, 2, 3 and 4 in 2020 and 2021. Categories are not mutually exclusive.



Unintentional and undetermined intent drug overdose deaths in Regions 1, 2, 3 and 4 in 2020 and 2021 most commonly occurred in July to August.


