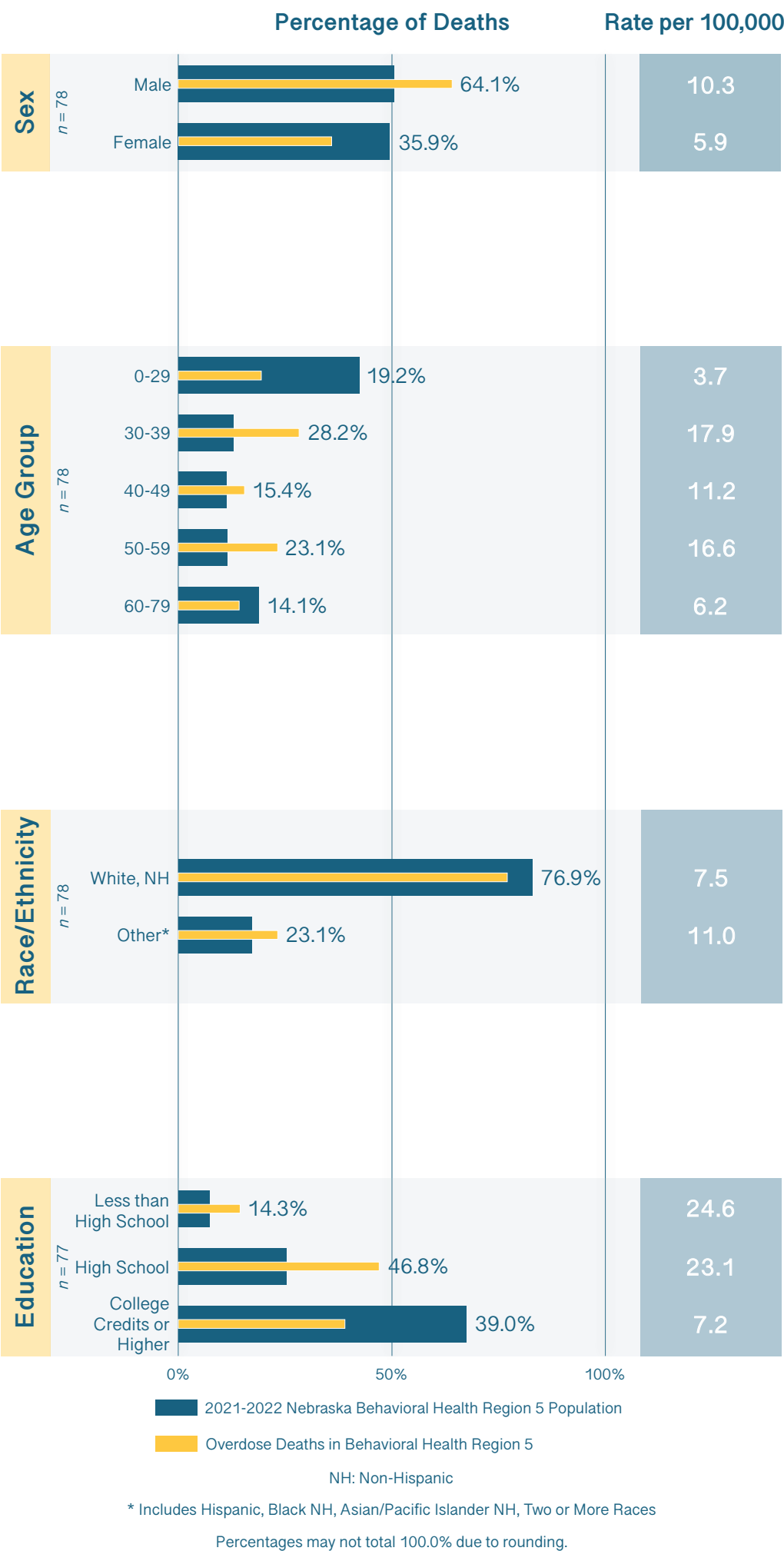


Summary of Drug Overdose Deaths in Behavioral Health Region 5 in Nebraska

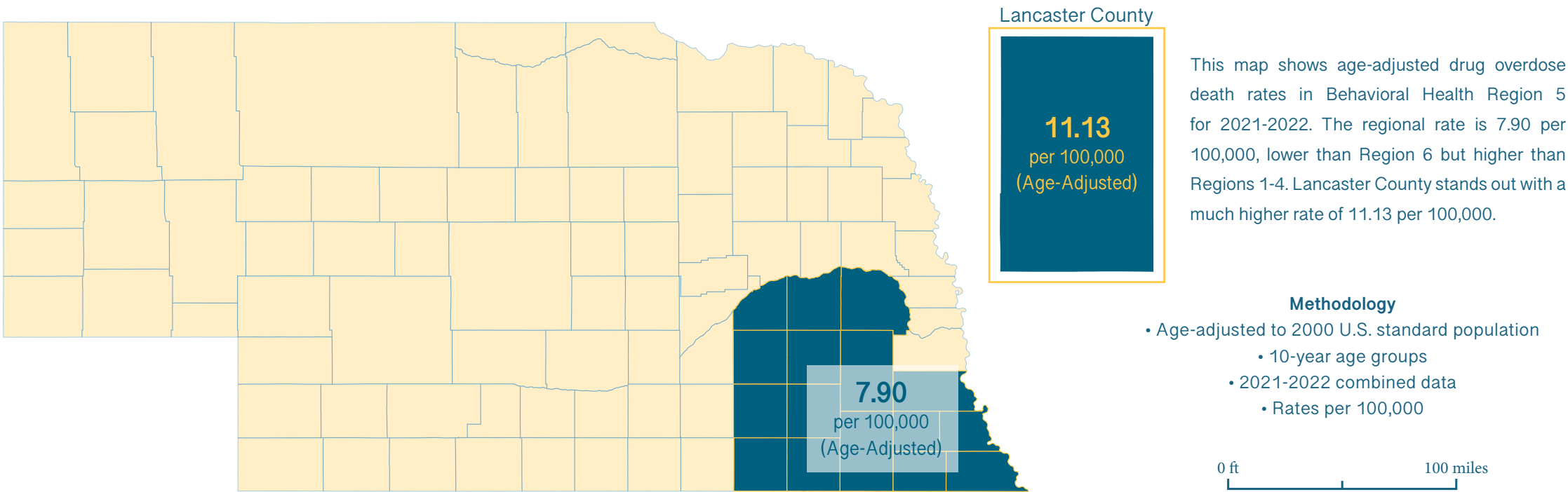

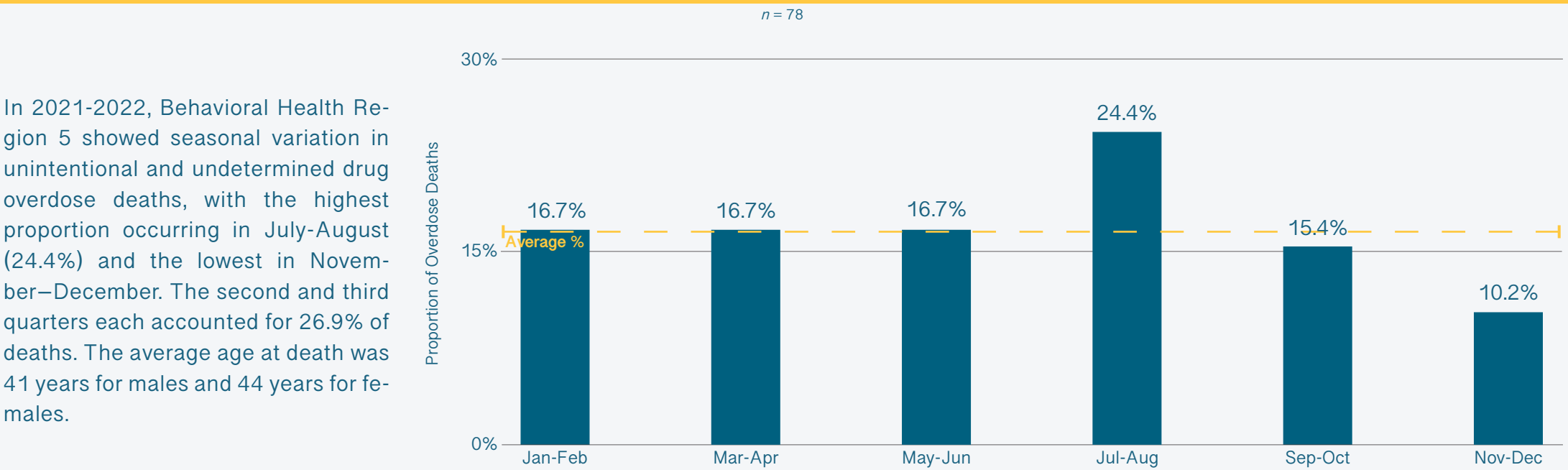


Between 2021 and 2022 in Behavioral Health Region 5, most unintentional and undetermined drug overdose deaths occurred among non-Hispanic White males aged 30-39 with a high school education. The average age at death was 42 years for non-Hispanic White males and 44 years for non-Hispanic White females.

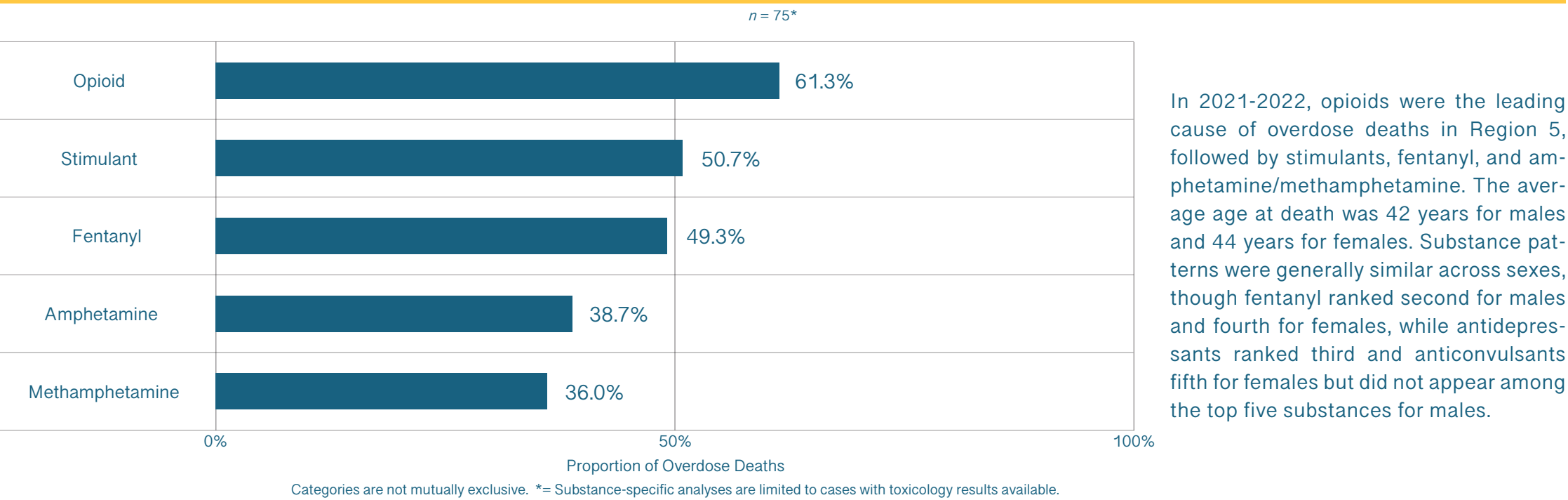
Age-Adjusted Drug Overdose Death Rate by Behavioral Health Regions



Drug Overdose Deaths by Bi-Month



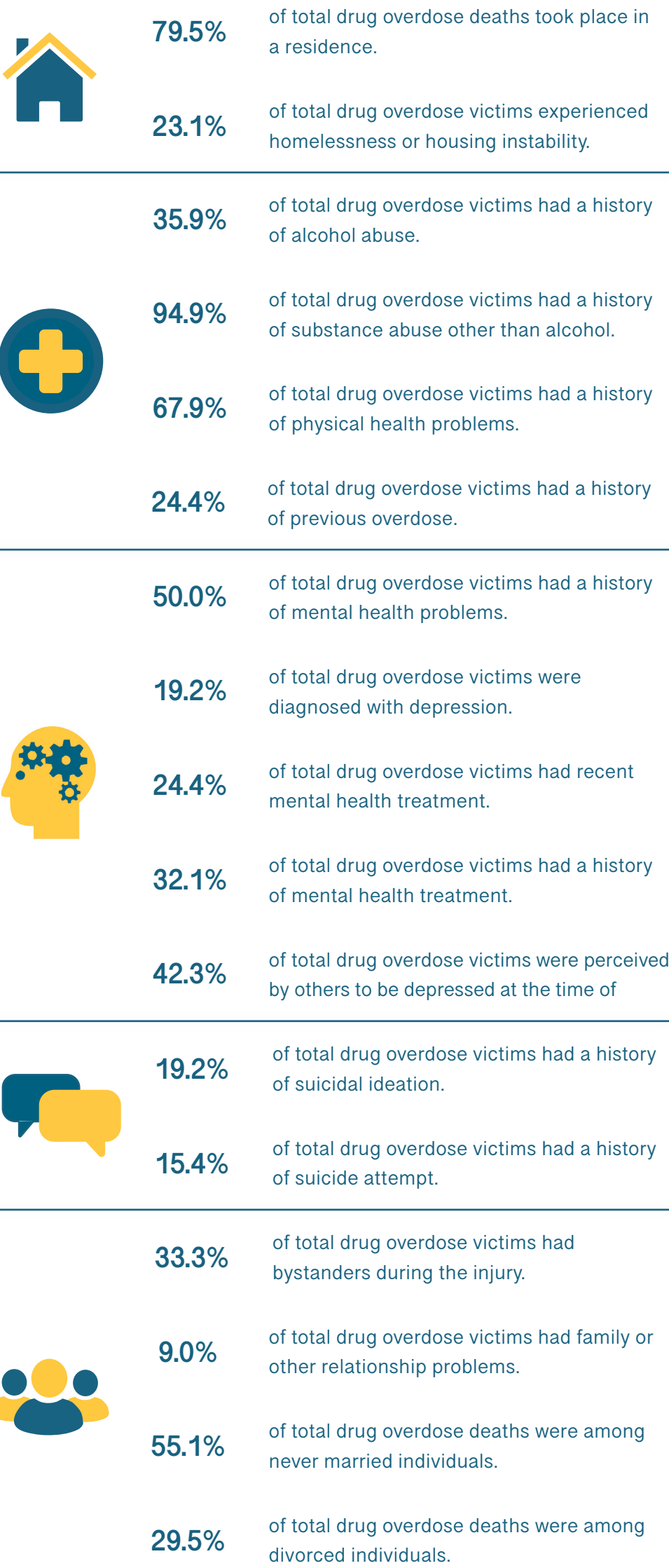
Common Substances Identified as the Cause of Death
