




## Summary of Homicide Deaths in Behavioral Health Region 5 and 6 in Nebraska



Between 2021 and 2022, in Nebraska's Behavioral Health Regions 5 and 6, the majority of homicide victims were males, Black non-Hispanic individuals, aged 20-29, with a high school diploma. Black non-Hispanic individuals were the demographic most disproportionately impacted by homicide deaths, with an average age of 28



Due to small numbers, rates may be unstable.

## **Other Decedent Characteristics** of total homicide deaths took place in a 45.7% of total homicide victims experienced 13.8% homelessness or housing instability. of total homicide victims had a history of 11.7% alcohol abuse. of total homicide victims had a history of 23.4% substance abuse other than alcohol. of total victims were killed during an illegal 10.6% drug dealing. of total victims were killed by a random act 9.6% of violence. of homicide deaths were classified as gang 14.9% of total vitims had emergency medical services present at the scene of total victims had 60 mins or less survival 28.7% of total victims were bystanders, not the **7.4**% intended targets. of total victims injured during an argument 33.0% or conflict. of total victims had an argument or conflict 38.3% that led to the victim's death. of total homicide deaths were related to conflict between intimate partners. of total homicide victims had family or 13.8% other relationship problems. of the homicide deaths were among never 71.3% married individuals. of the homicide deaths were among 14.9% married individuals.

The reduced death count in this section is due to incomplete law enforcement or coroner reports.
