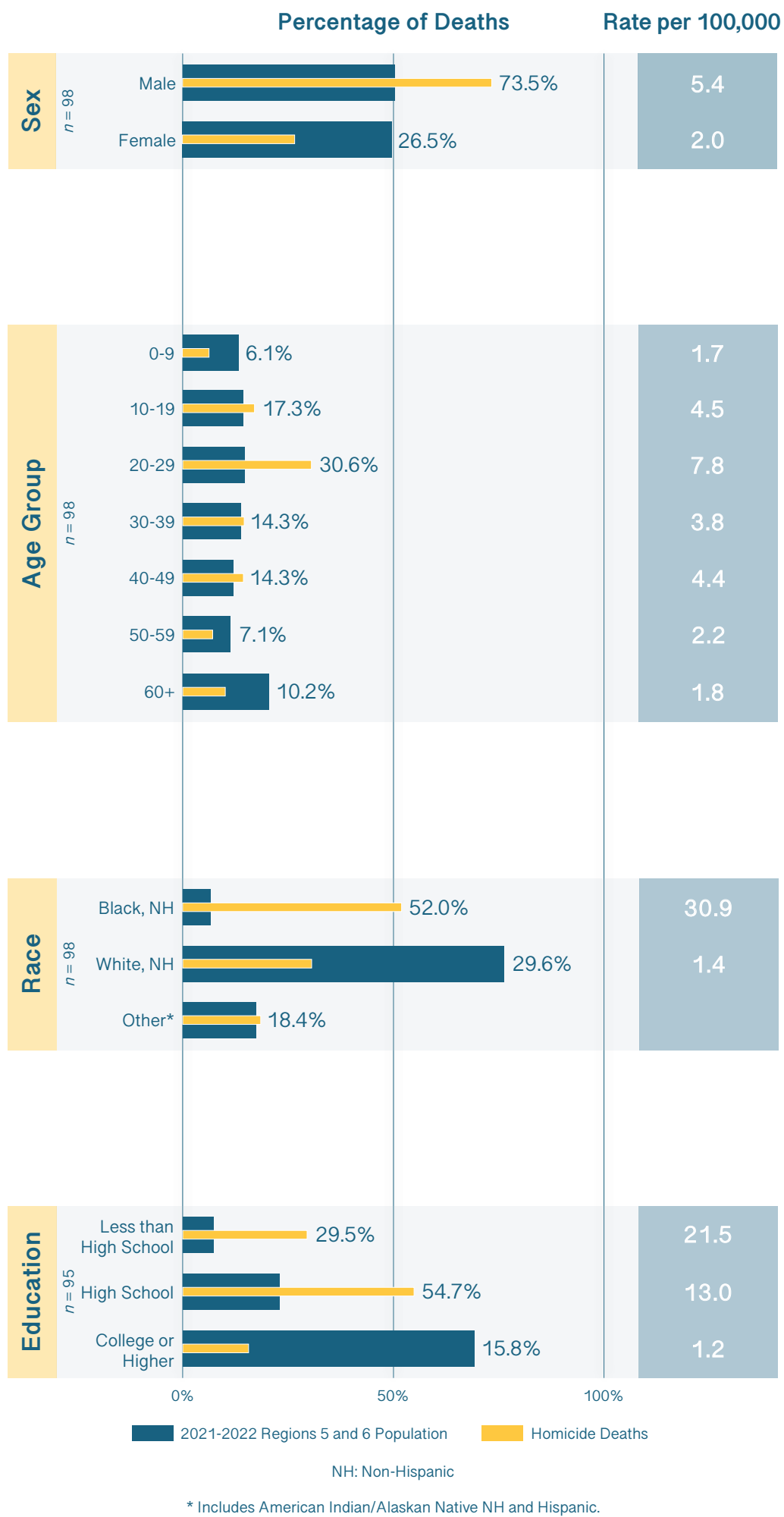


Summary of Homicide Deaths in Behavioral Health Region 5 and 6 in Nebraska

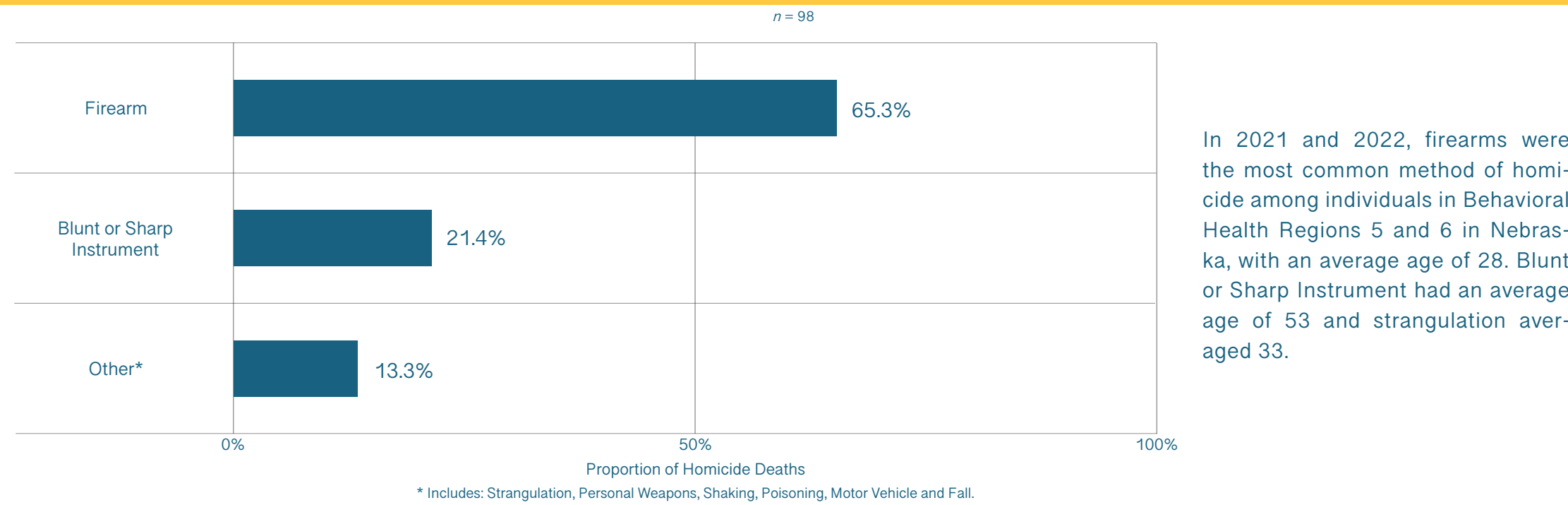
98 Total Deaths (3.7 per 100,000 Population)

Demographic Information



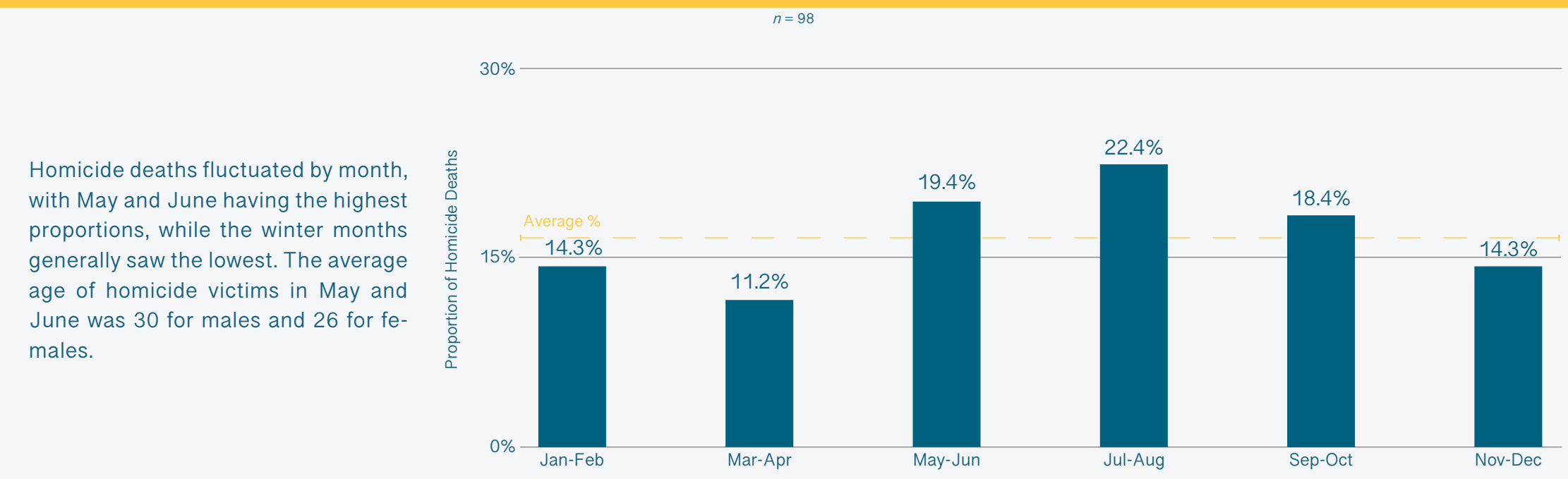
Between 2021 and 2022, in Nebraska's Behavioral Health Regions 5 and 6, the majority of homicide victims were males, Black non-Hispanic individuals, aged 20-29, with a high school diploma. Black non-Hispanic individuals were the demographic most disproportionately impacted by homicide deaths, with an average age of 28.

Cause of Death



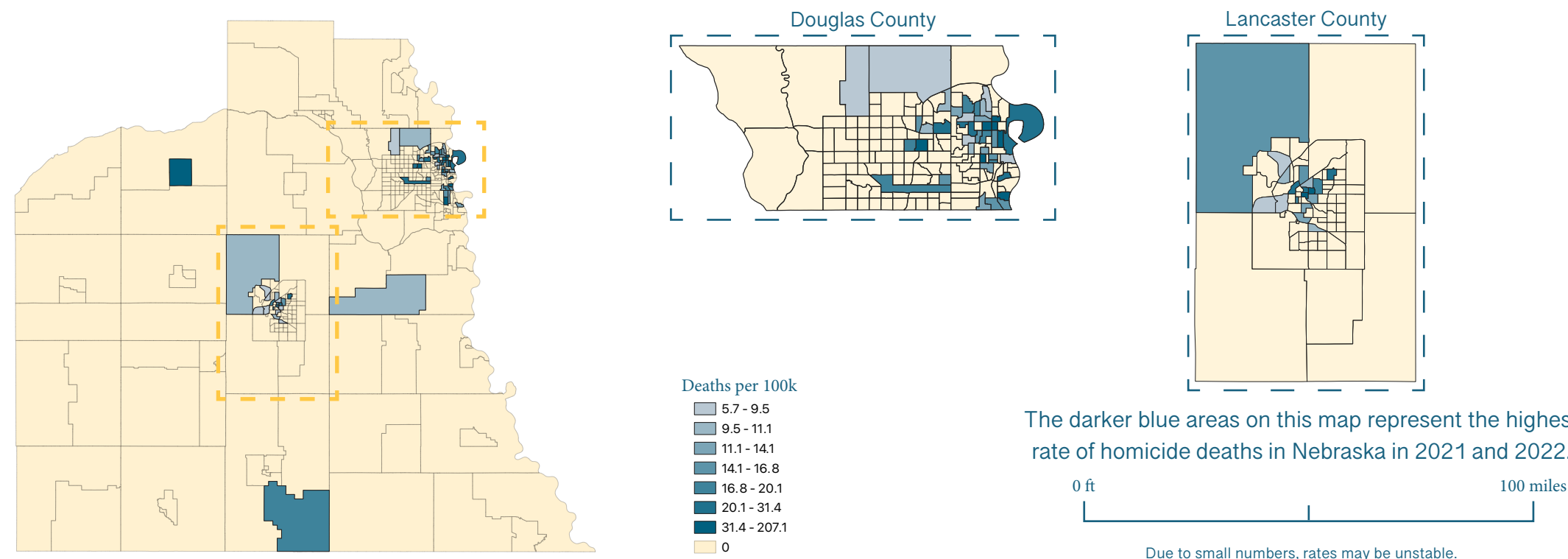
In 2021 and 2022, firearms were the most common method of homicide among individuals in Behavioral Health Regions 5 and 6 in Nebraska, with an average age of 28. Blunt or Sharp Instrument had an average age of 53 and strangulation averaged 33.

Homicide Deaths by Month



Homicide deaths fluctuated by month, with May and June having the highest proportions, while the winter months generally saw the lowest. The average age of homicide victims in May and June was 30 for males and 26 for females.
