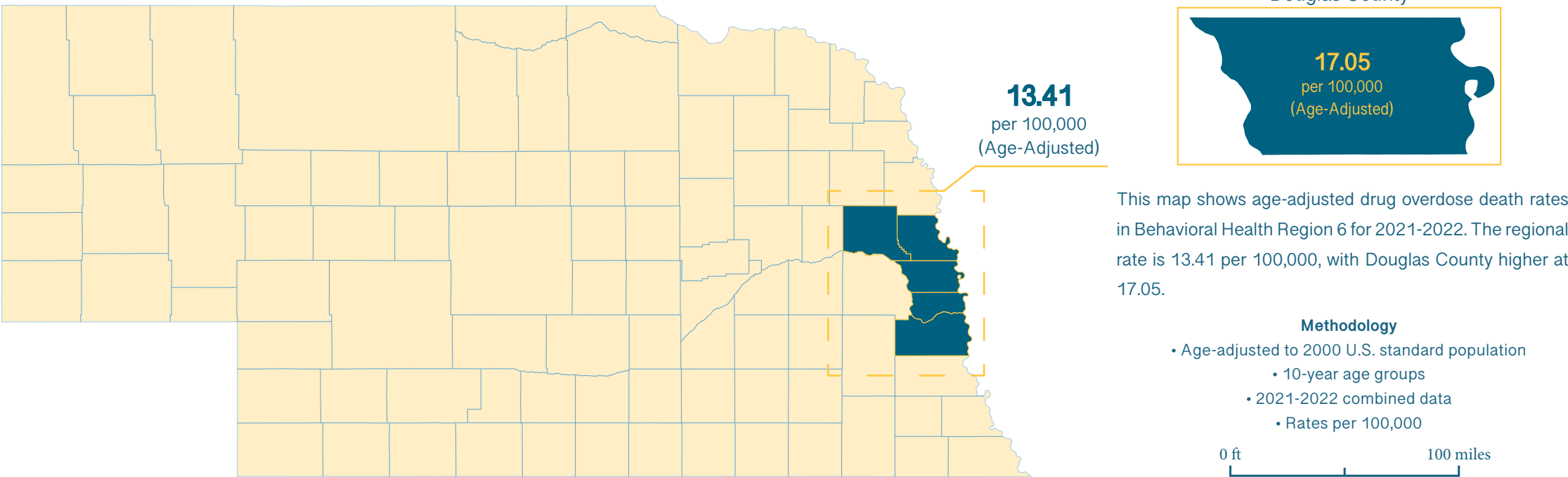

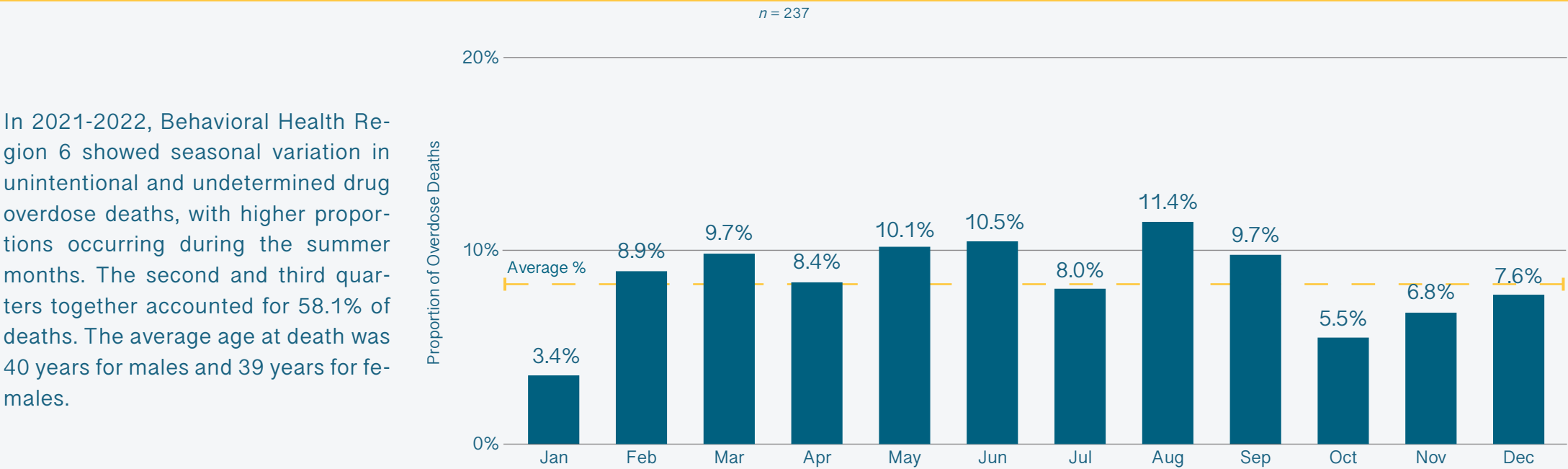

Between 2021 and 2022 in Behavioral Health Region 6, most unintentional and undetermined drug overdose deaths occurred among non-Hispanic White males aged 30-39 with a high school education or less. The average age at death was 40 years for non-Hispanic White males and 43 years for non-Hispanic White females. Non-Hispanic Black individuals were also disproportionately affected, with an average age at death of 39 years for males and 38 years for females.

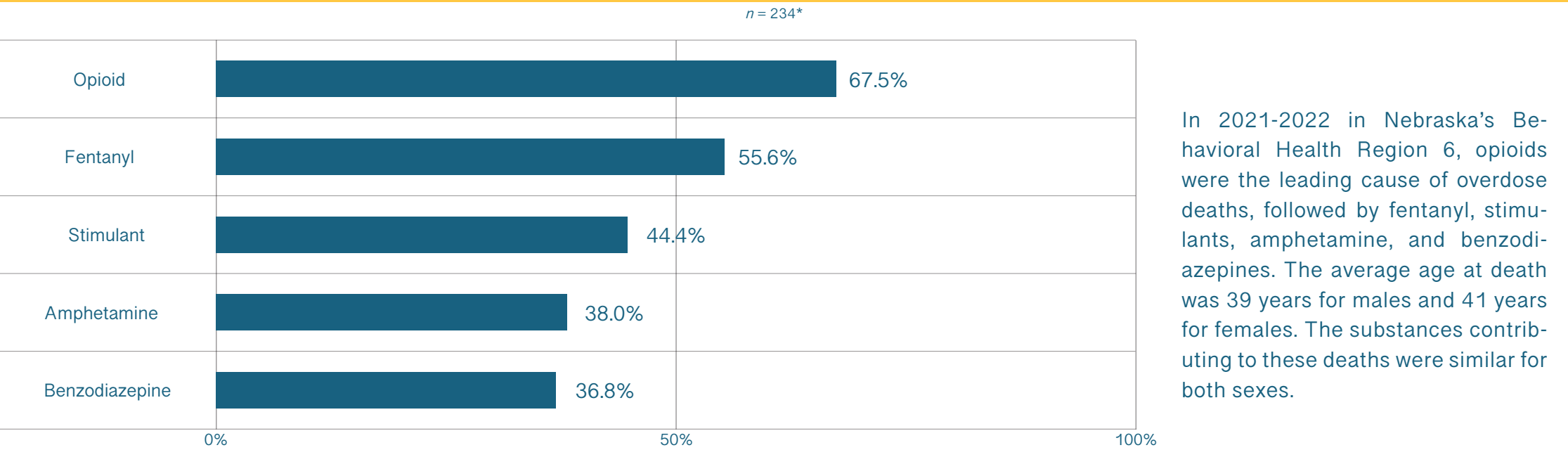
Age-Adjusted Drug Overdose Death Rate by Behavioral Health Regions

Common Substances Identified as the Cause of Death



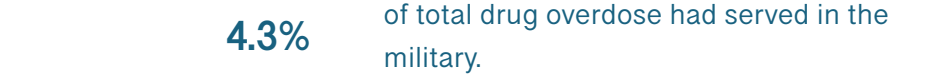
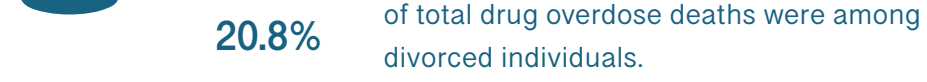
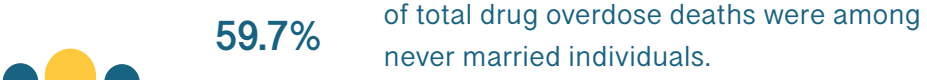
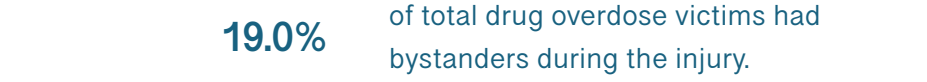
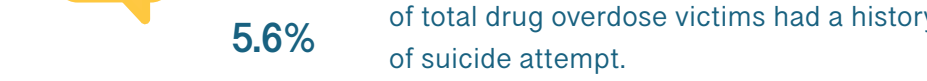
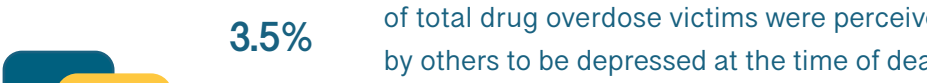
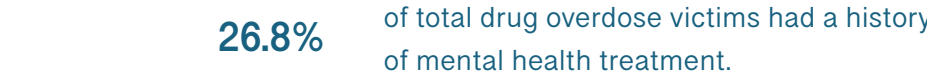
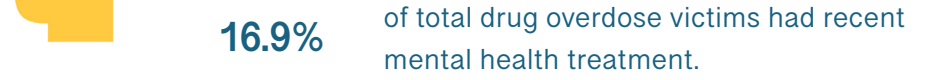
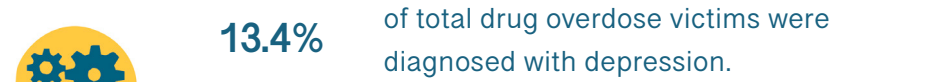
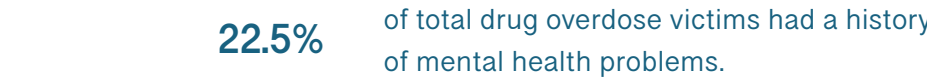
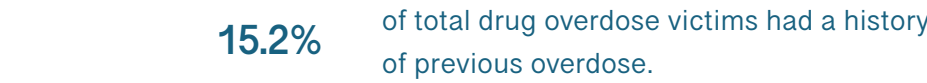
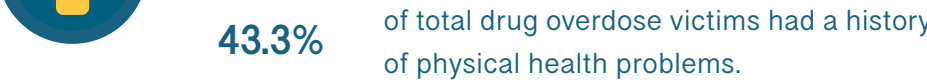
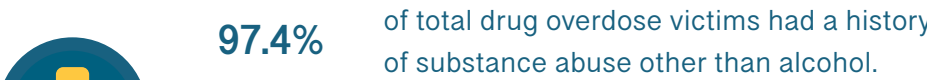
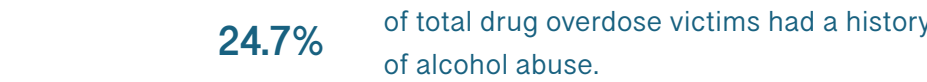
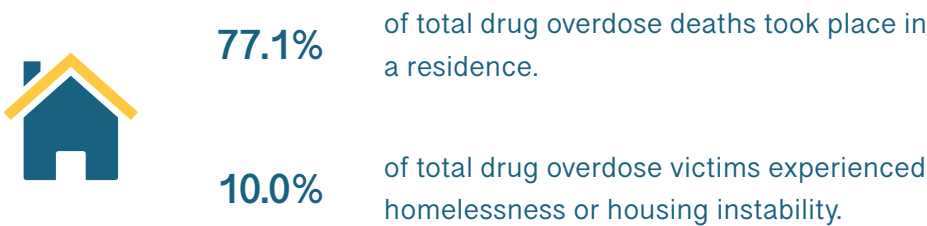

In 2021-2022 in Nebraska's Behavioral Health Region 6, opioids were the leading cause of overdose deaths, followed by fentanyl, stimulants, amphetamine, and benzodiazepines. The average age at death was 39 years for males and 41 years for females. The substances contributing to these deaths were similar for both sexes.
