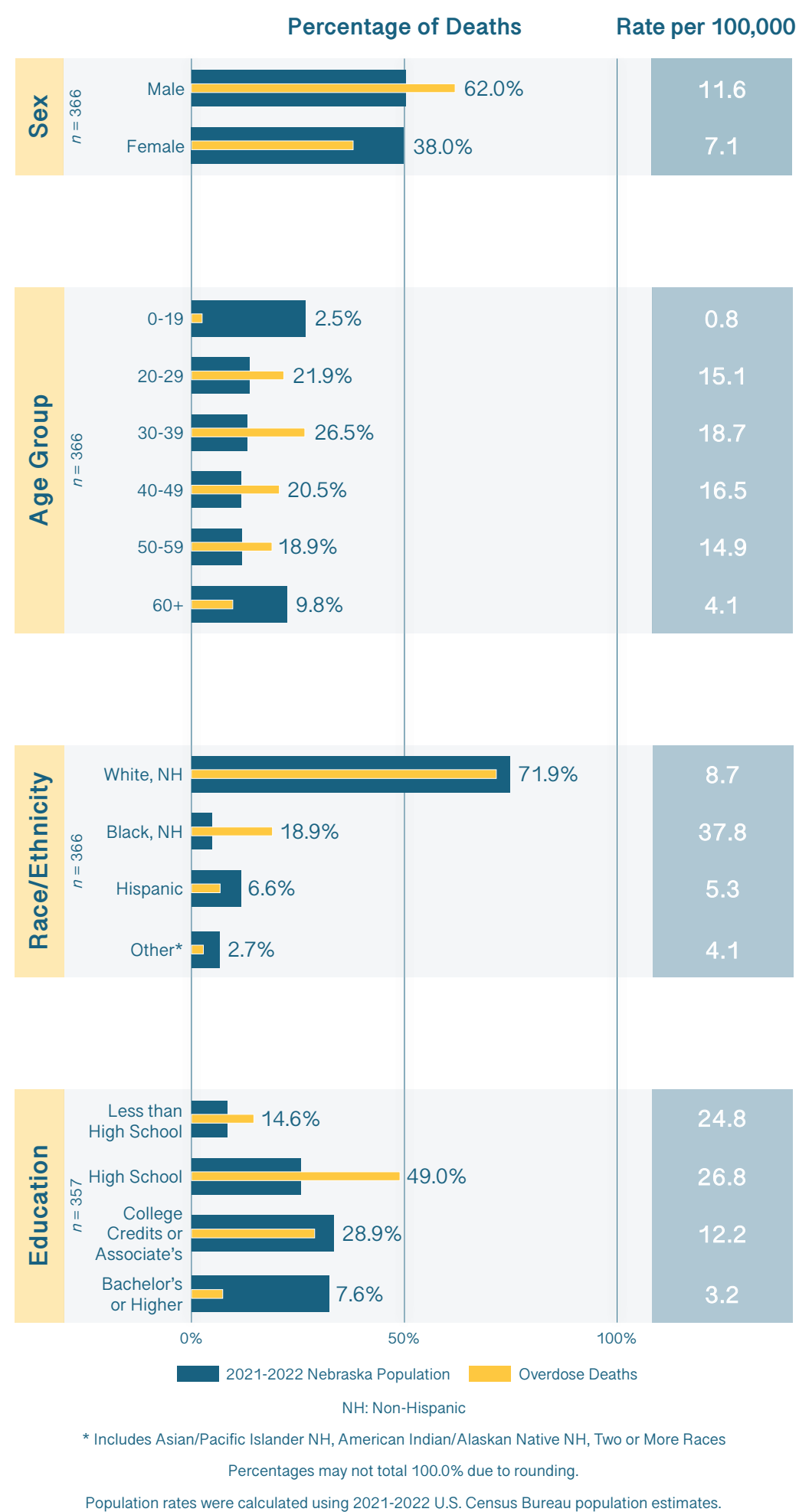


Summary of Drug Overdose Deaths in Nebraska

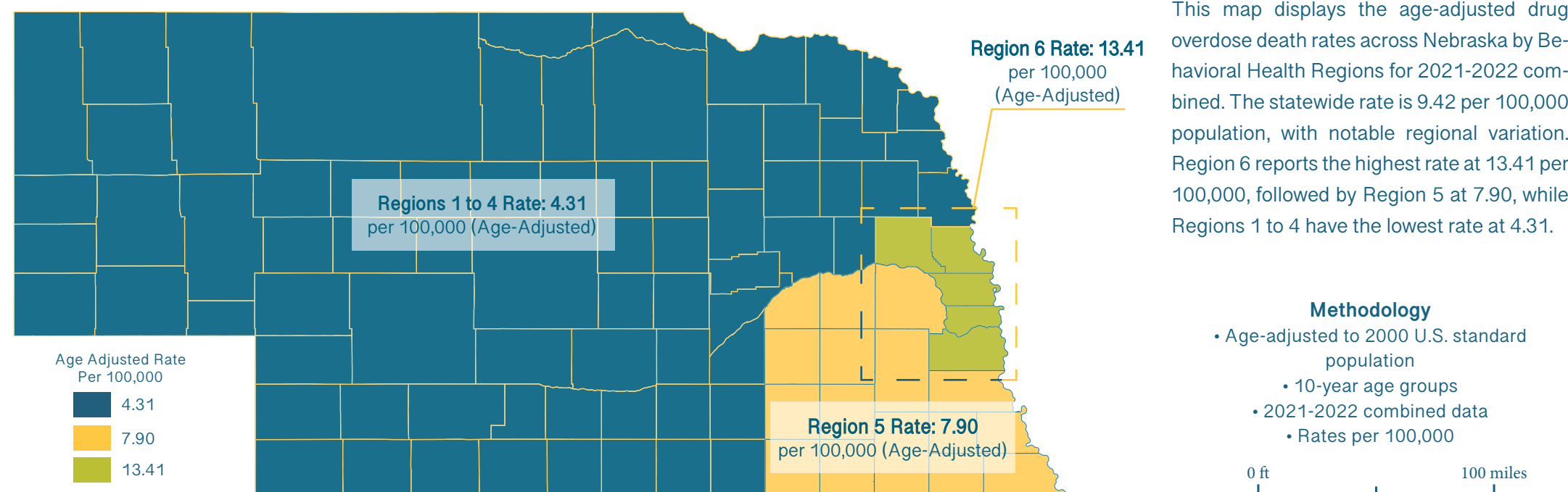
366 Total Deaths (9.6 per 100,000 Population)

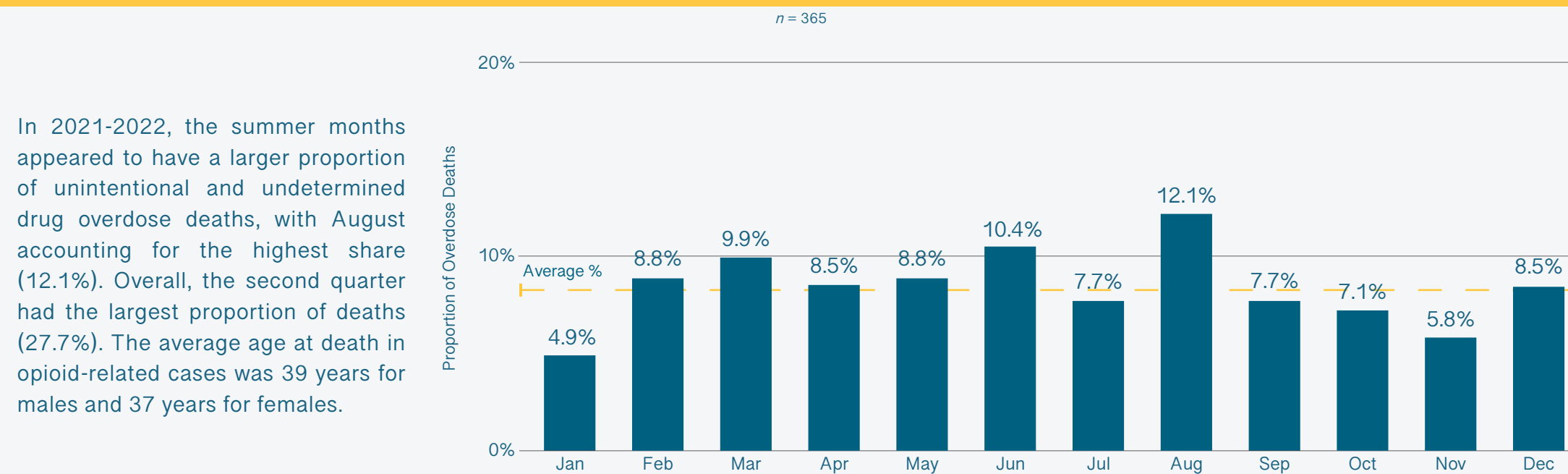


Between 2021 and 2022 in Nebraska, most unintentional and undetermined drug overdose deaths occurred among non-Hispanic White males aged 30-39 with a high school education or less. The average age at death was 40 years for non-Hispanic White males and 43 years for non-Hispanic White females. Non-Hispanic Black individuals were also disproportionately affected, with an average age at death of 40 years for both males and females.

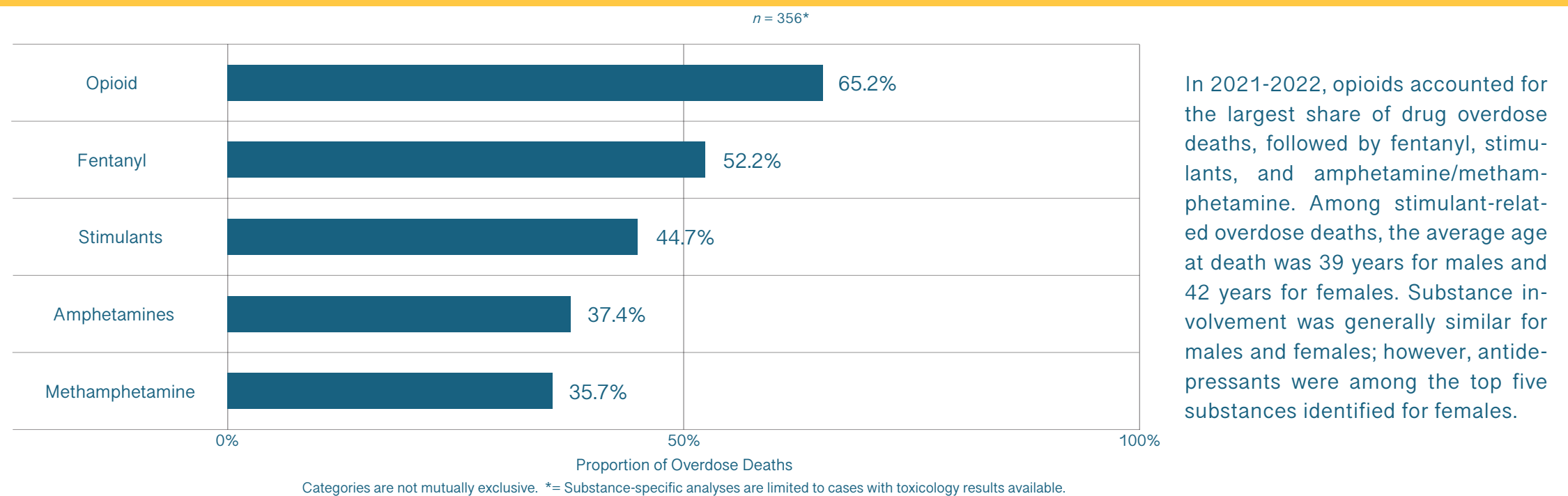
Age-Adjusted Drug Overdose Death Rate in Nebraska



Drug Overdose Deaths by Month



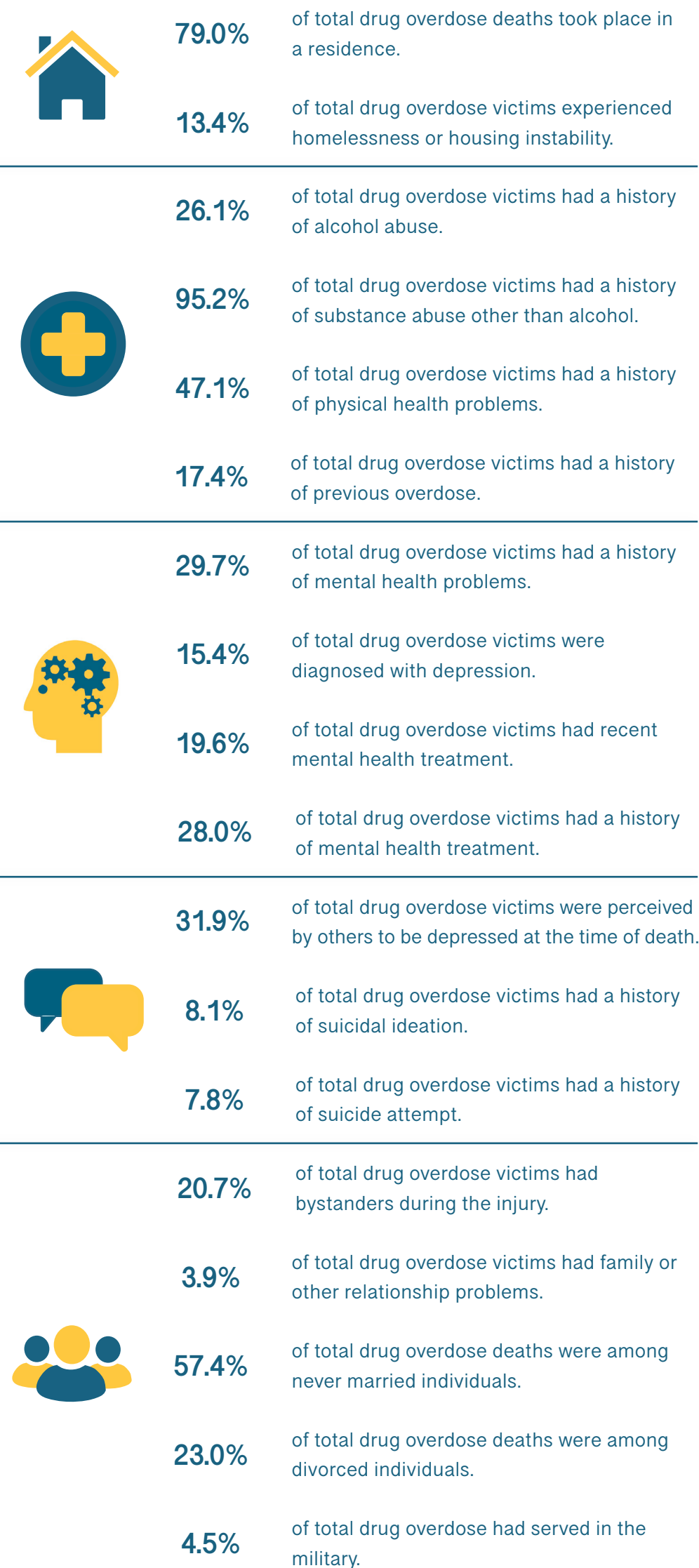
Common Substances Identified as the Cause of Death
