The Women's and Men's Health Programs (WMHP) within Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (NDHHS) launched this new initiative in June 2025 to host Statewide Breast and Cervical Cancer Engagement Meetings. These meetings are a key strategy to help us use local data, community insights, and statewide collaboration to reduce breast and cervical cancer disparities in Nebraska. In total there is to be 6 separate meetings. There are 21 priority counties throughout the state that have a higher breast and cervical cancer burden and inequities. Our hope in hosting these meetings with key partners is to strategize effective approaches to increase breast and cervical cancer screening rates.

- ✓ **The 1st engagement meeting took place on Thursday, June 12, 2025, and covered the counties of:** Madison, Platte, Colfax, Dodge, Saunders, Washington and Dakota
- ✓ **The 2nd engagement meeting took place on Thursday, August 14, 2025, and covered the county of:** Lancaster
- **The 3rd engagement meeting is scheduled to take place on Thursday, September 18, 2025, and cover the counties of:** DOUGLAS, SARPY and CASS
