Citizen Review Panel members are active participants and engage meaningfully in Panel discussions. Any citizen residing in Nebraska with considerable and relevant experience is eligible to be a Panel member.

Quarterly meetings are held in Lincoln, Nebraska. Parking reimbursement is available on request.

Responsibilities include:

- A commitment to confidentiality
- Quarterly meetings to review Child Welfare cases
- Sharing expertise to improve other panel members' understanding of the investigation of child welfare cases.
- Providing feedback to generate annual recommendations based on collected data from case reviews

- Child advocates/guardians ad litem
- Health providers
- Mental health and substance misuse professionals
- Law enforcement representatives
