The COVID-19 vaccine is rolling out across Nebraska. And while it may seem like a long wait, it's so worth it. Once most Nebraskans get both vaccination doses, we'll be able to start returning to normal again.

When can I get vaccinated?

The vaccines are going to the most vulnerable first – the front-line health care workers and the elderly. After that, there will be a phased approach rollout to the rest of the population. Sign up at FinishStrong.Ne.Gov to be notified when it's your turn.

Do I still need to wear a mask once I get the vaccine?

Yes, you'll still need to mask up, social distance and avoid large gatherings after you're vaccinated. Vaccines help lessen the spread of the virus by making the whole population less susceptible. So we need to achieve "herd immunity" by getting most people vaccinated before we can go back to normal. You can do your part to help us get there by getting the vaccine when it's your turn.

Is the vaccine safe? It came out so quickly!

Actually, the best infectious disease scientists had been working on a vaccine for almost a year before it was released. It was released quickly because it was a fully funded initiative with the full power of the scientific community behind it. Reported side effects are generally mild, and both the Pfizer and Moderna vaccine have shown about 95% effectiveness at preventing mild and severe coronavirus symptoms.
