

Central Registry Fee Increase FAQ

When will the new fee take effect?

The updated fee will take effect on November 1, 2025.

What is the new fee amount?

The Central Registry checks will change from \$2.50 to \$3.00. The online verification fee (\$1.00) and online processing fee (\$1.50) will remain the same.

Why is the fee changing?

The fee is being adjusted to support the continued delivery of timely, accurate, and reliable Central Registry services.

Who is required to pay the fee?

Anyone requesting a Central Registry check, including individuals, employers, and agencies, will be subject to the updated fee.

How do I submit payment?

Payments may be submitted through the online portal by credit/debit card, or by check or money order with a mail-in form.

Will the fee change affect the processing time for a check?

The fee adjustment is expected to have a positive impact on processing times. By supporting the resources needed to manage requests, the change aims to improve the turnaround time for Central Registry checks.
