# N-FOCUS Interim Release Combined All Divisions January 12, 2025

An Interim Release of the N-FOCUS System is being implemented January 12, 2025. This document provides information explaining new functionality, enhancements and problem resolutions made effective with this release. This document is divided into four main sections and addresses all of the Divisions, MLTC, EA, CFS and DD.

**General Interest and Mainframe Topics**: All N-FOCUS users should read this section.

**ACCESSNebraska:** N-FOCUS workers responsible for case activity received through the Web Based Electronic Application should read this section.

**Home and Community Based Services:** NFOCUS workers who work directly with DD Programs and those who work with the related Medicaid cases should read this section.

**Note:** This section will only appear when there are tips, enhancements or fixes specific to Developmental Disabilities Programs.

**Expert System:** All N-FOCUS workers with responsibilities for case entry for AABD, ADA Payment SNAP, LIHEAP, LIHWAP, CC, FL, MED, Retro MED should read this section.

**Note:** When new functionality is added to N-FOCUS that crosses multiple topics (i.e. General Interest and Mainframe, Alerts, Correspondence, Expert System etc.) the functionality will be described in one primary location. This location will usually be the General Interest and Mainframe section or the Expert System section. Alerts Work Tasks and Correspondence that are part of the new functionality may be documented in both the primary location that describes the entire process in addition to being in the Alerts, Work Tasks and Correspondence sections.

Interfaces, Document Imaging and N-FOCUS Tips sections will be added as appropriate for the release.

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
#### **General Interest and Mainframe**

#### EA - Child Care Service Authorization Updates (Change)

Service changes are being made to Child Care service authorizations:

1. Child Care authorizations will have an age check when selecting an authorization service type. If a SSW/Lead/SSW Sup selects a service type that the child is not age appropriate for they will receive a message indicating they are not the correct age.

For example, if the child is 4 years old and the worker tries to select Toddler Auth type, they will receive this message:



Workers will select okay and make the correct selection.

2. Max hours per week is now required. The value must be greater than zero. This is required before the worker updates the units. If they select units/rates before adding in a value to Max Hours Per Week box or make changes to existing authorizations and try to save/close without updating this box, they will receive this message:



The numerical value is expected to match the household need but will not affect the authorization. It is used for reporting needs.


3. SSW/Leads/Sups will no longer be able to correct end date. This is grayed out and only policy has access to select this.




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4. Specific Child Care Authorizations will have the customer obligation box unchecked and grayed out – regardless of family fee. This will prevent the family fee from appearing on the providers portal when they are billing on authorizations that do not require family fee. This change will only affect the following CC service types:

Transportation
Quality Incentive
Activity Fee
Enrollment Fee
Reimbursement
FA/CPR Reimbursement
Overtime



5. When closing an existing auth, the recalculating box is checked and grayed out. This will allow the units to automatically to recalculate based on the new end date.



6. Deleting Child Care authorizations that are in create status and changes were made:

Childcare authorizations that are in create status – they have not been printed local or have not been printed overnight yet – and the worker makes a change, the first auth will delete from the notice list and only the updated auth will appear. This means only the most updated auth will send to the household and only one auth will be sent to the provider billing portal. If a worker prints local and then goes back in and makes a change then both authorizations will appear in the notice list – this is because the system registers that one was already printed and sent out.


## MLTC – Flexible Budgeting Project Initial Updates (Change)

#### **Expiry Date Access in GEN Screens**


- Detail Program Case Screen Enhancements:

  - Purpose

These columns provide read-only access to expiry case details. Users will be able to view all relevant details in one place, improving efficiency and ease of use.



#### **Benefit Summary Screen Enhancements**



It was previously required that foster parent contact with the parent/guardian was to occur within 24 hours. The time period has changed. The wording on this section of the window has been changed to omit a specific length of time as illustrated in the screen shot below:

# All Divisions - New Integrated Unemployment Compensation (IUC) Disqualified Reason Code (New)

The Department of Labor has added a new Unemployment disqualified reason code of 'Failure to Report – Drug or Alcohol Use at Work.' This new code has been added to the corresponding N-FOCUS code table and will be viewable on the IUC screen.

## EA - LIHEAP Supplemental Accounts Receivable Recoupment (Fix)

An issue was found in the recoupment process for LIHEAP supplemental payments in which subsequent regular heating and cooling Explanation of Benefits reports to providers were showing an incorrect amount. The Expert System fix will go into effect with the interim release following with the batch update being implemented January 15<sup>th</sup>.
