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Introduction

This dashboard presents tabulations of statistical information from records of induced abortions performed in Nebraska beginning with calendar year 2024. These data are collected and reported in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 28-343 through Neb. Rev. Stat. § 28-345, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 28-3,107, and Neb. Rev. Stat. § 71-6909.

The enactment of the Preborn Child Protection Act did not change the reporting requirements under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 28-3,107, which required the Department to report certain information related to abortions occurring twenty or more weeks postfertilization. Neb. Rev. Stat. § 28-3,107 was amended in 2025 to match the requirements of the Preborn Child Protection Act. This change was effective September 3, 2025. As a result, some data from procedures performed prior September 3, 2025, will reflect the twenty week reporting requirement. Data for procedures performed after September 3, 2025, will reflect the updated requirements.

About This Dashboard

This dashboard provides an interactive overview of reported abortion data in Nebraska. It allows users to explore annual trends, patient characteristics, geographic patterns, and reported clinical details for the available reporting years.

The dashboard presents information on total reported abortions, abortion rates, patient age, race and ethnicity, education level, marital status, previous pregnancies, previous births, previous abortions, state and county of residence, procedure type, gestational week, reported reasons, complications, emergency situations, and exceptions. Users may select a reporting year using the Year filter and navigate through the dashboard by using the page tabs. The current dashboard includes information beginning with calendar year 2024. Annual reports in PDF format are accessible through the "Annual Data Summaries (PDF)" link located in the dashboard header.

Data Notes

The information shown is based on records submitted to the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services. Some categories may appear as "Not reported", "Unknown", "Not classifiable", or "Not measurable" when information was missing, unavailable, not applicable, or could not be determined. Percentages may not total 100 percent due to rounding. Small counts should be interpreted with caution and may be grouped or suppressed to protect privacy.

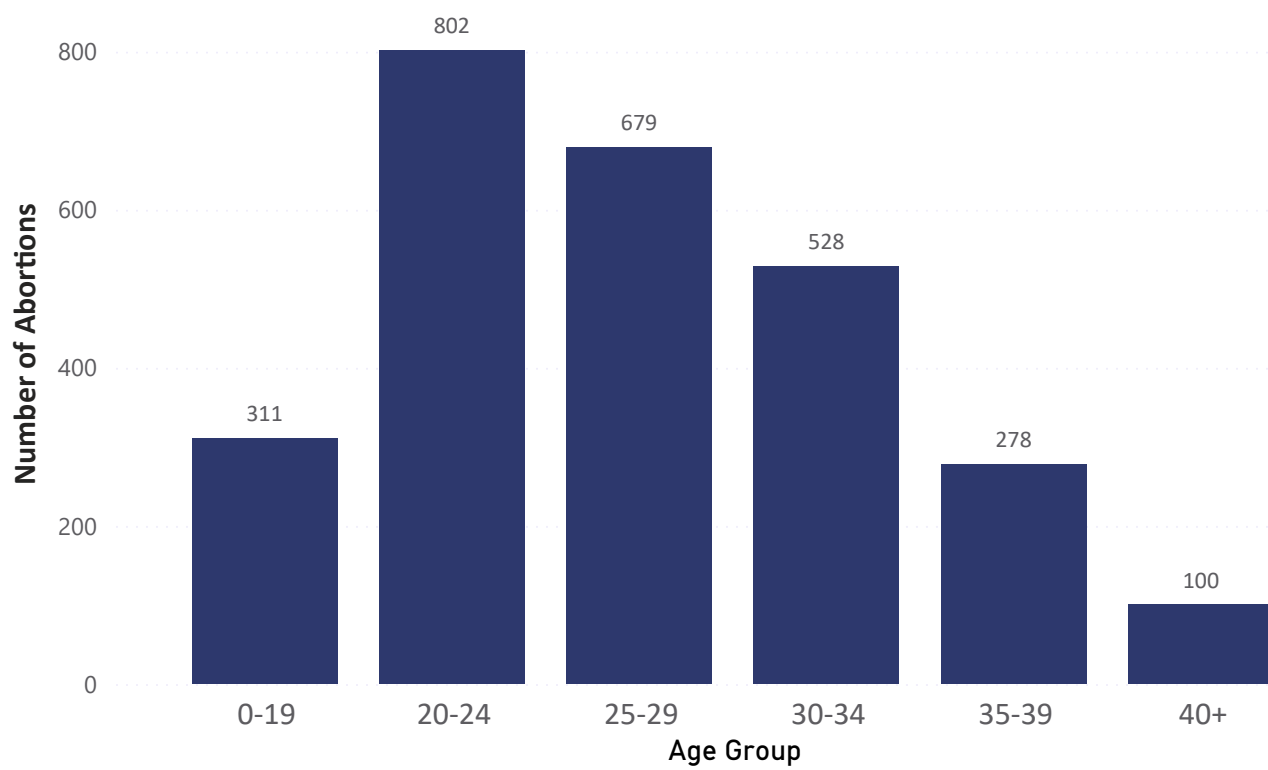

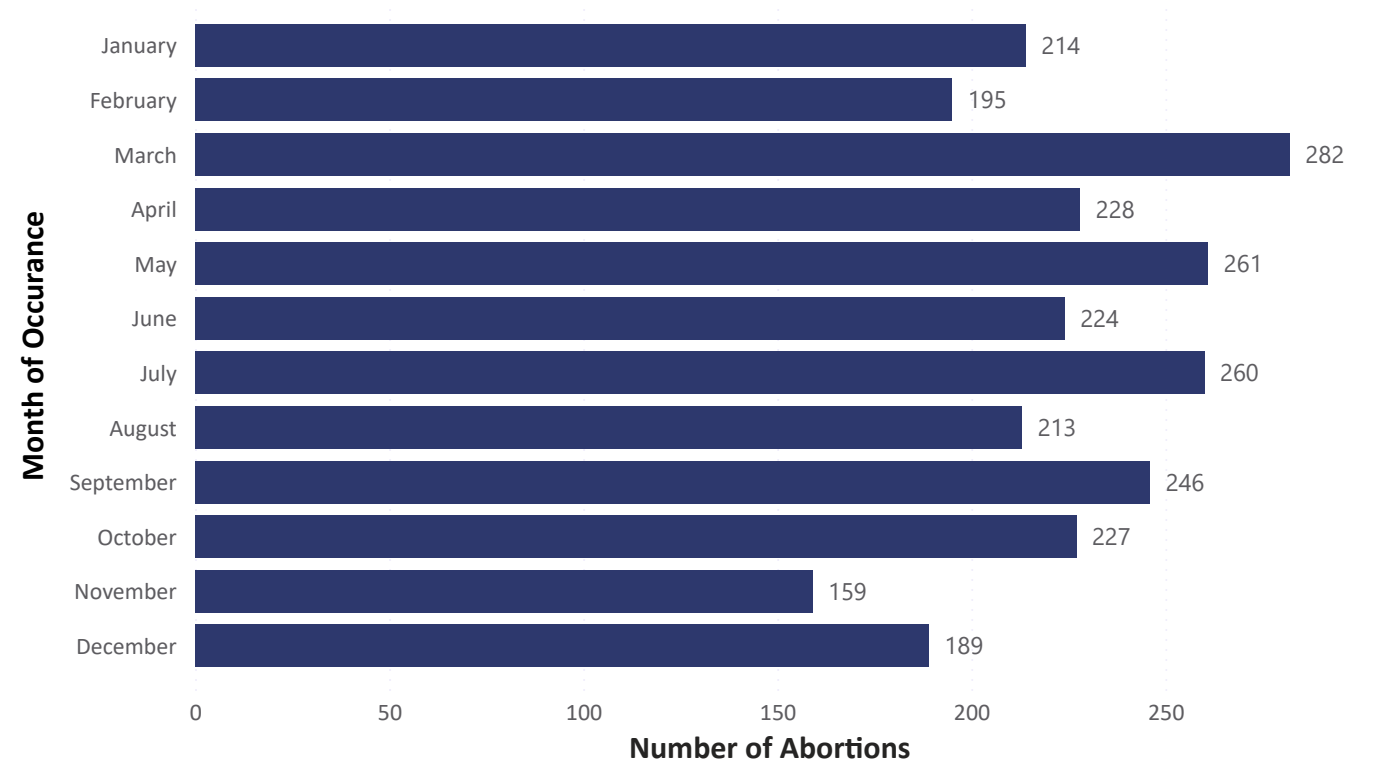

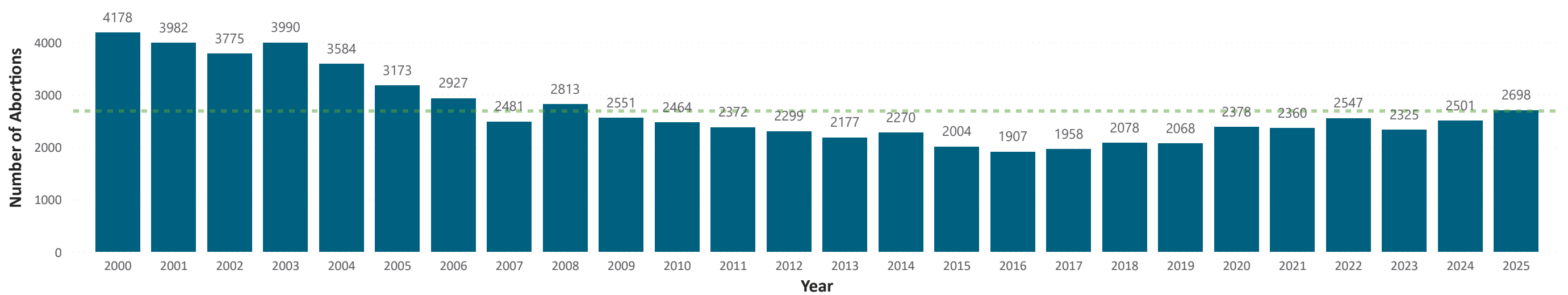
Number of Abortion by Patient Age Group, Year: 2025



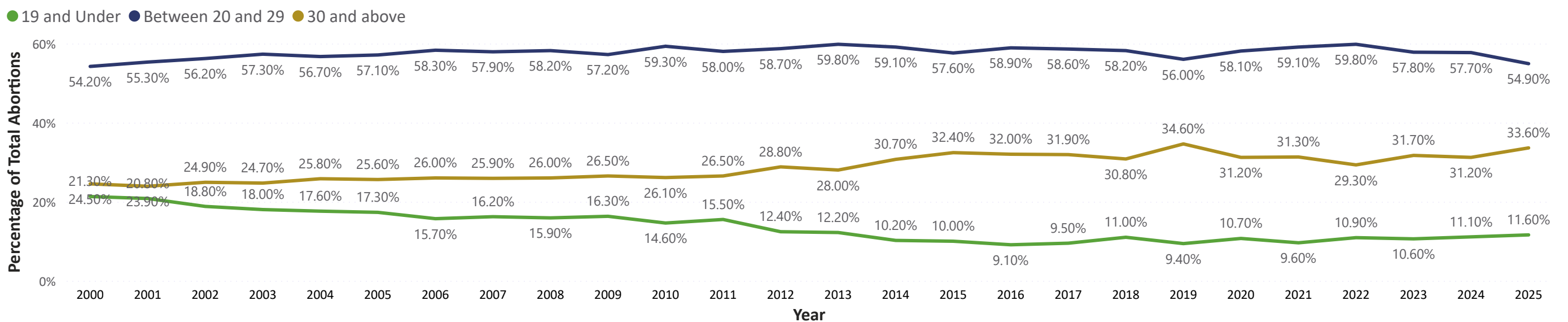
Number of Abortions by Month of Occurrence, Year: 2025

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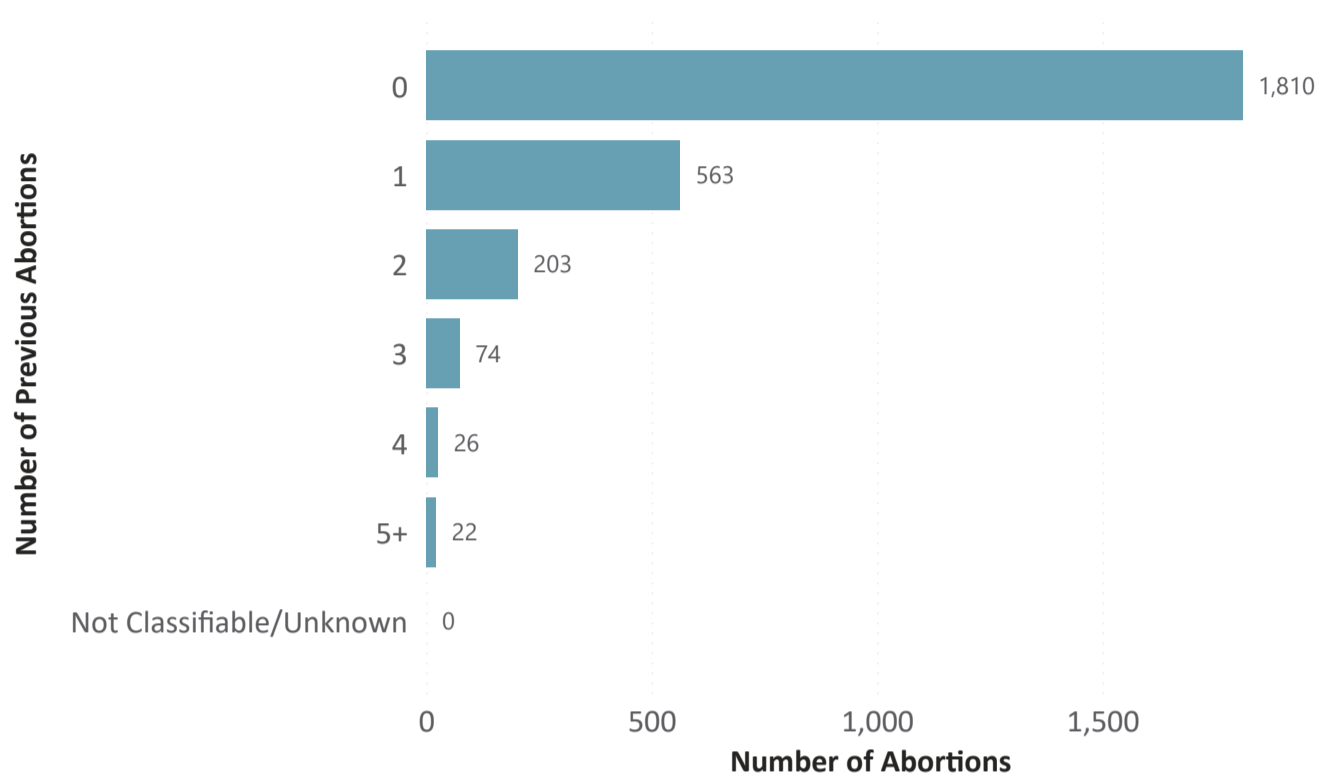
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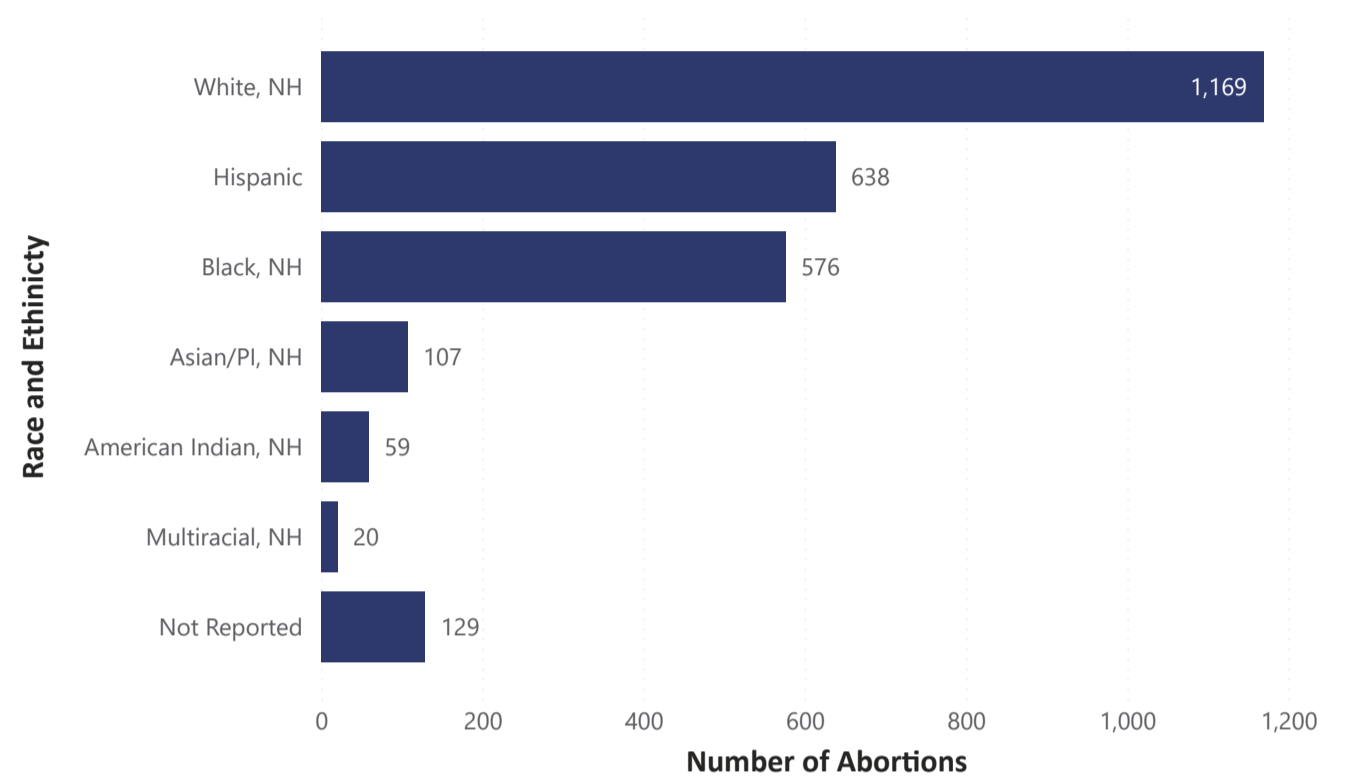

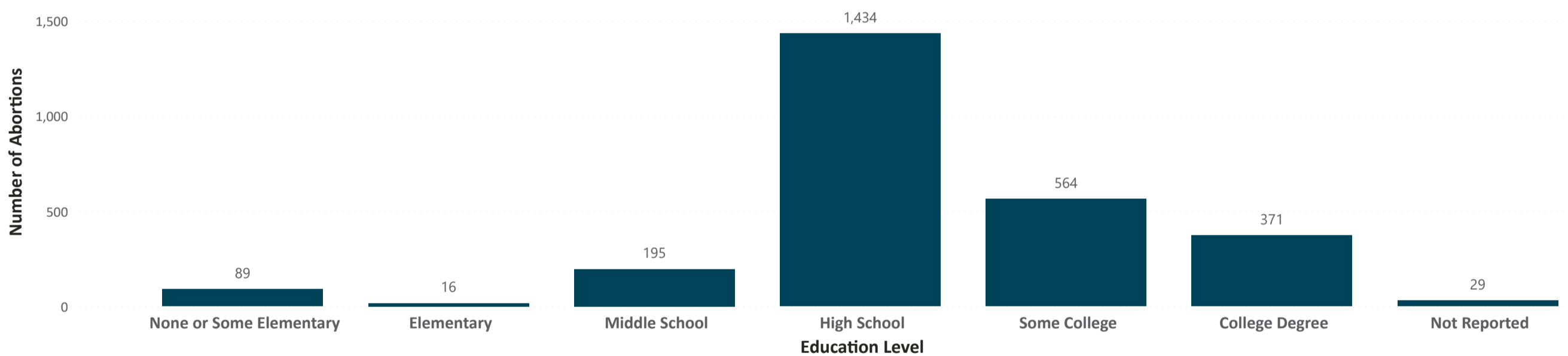
Number of Abortions by Number of Previous Abortions, Year: 2025



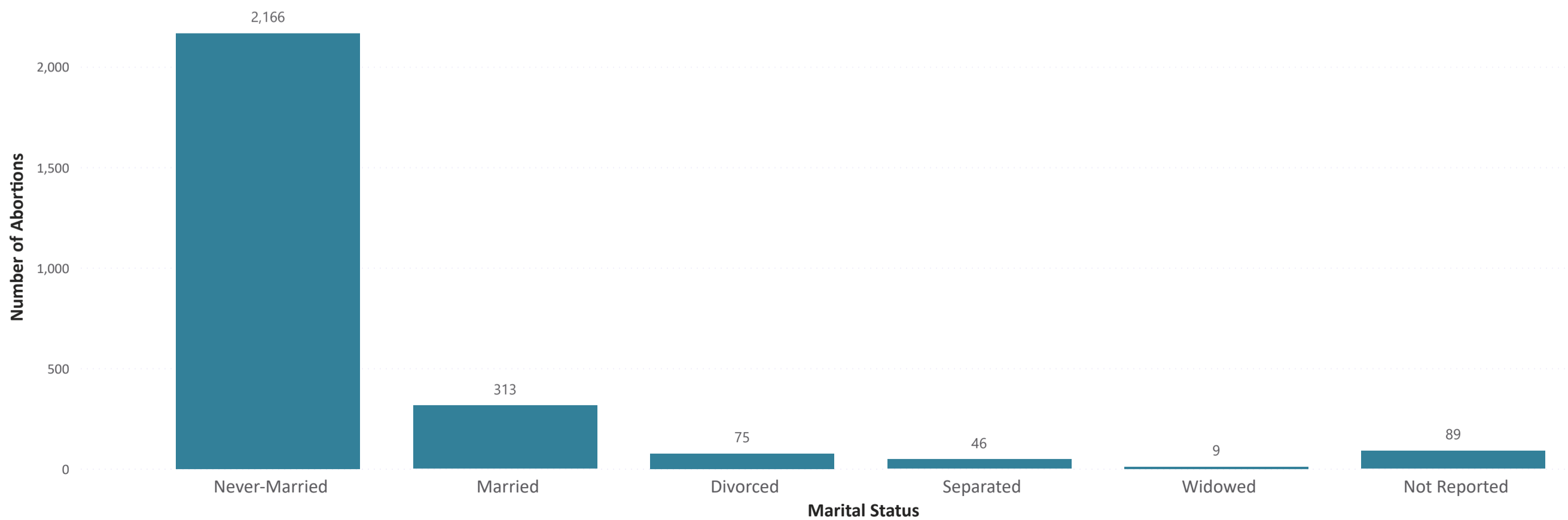
Number of Abortions by Race and Ethnicity, Year: 2025

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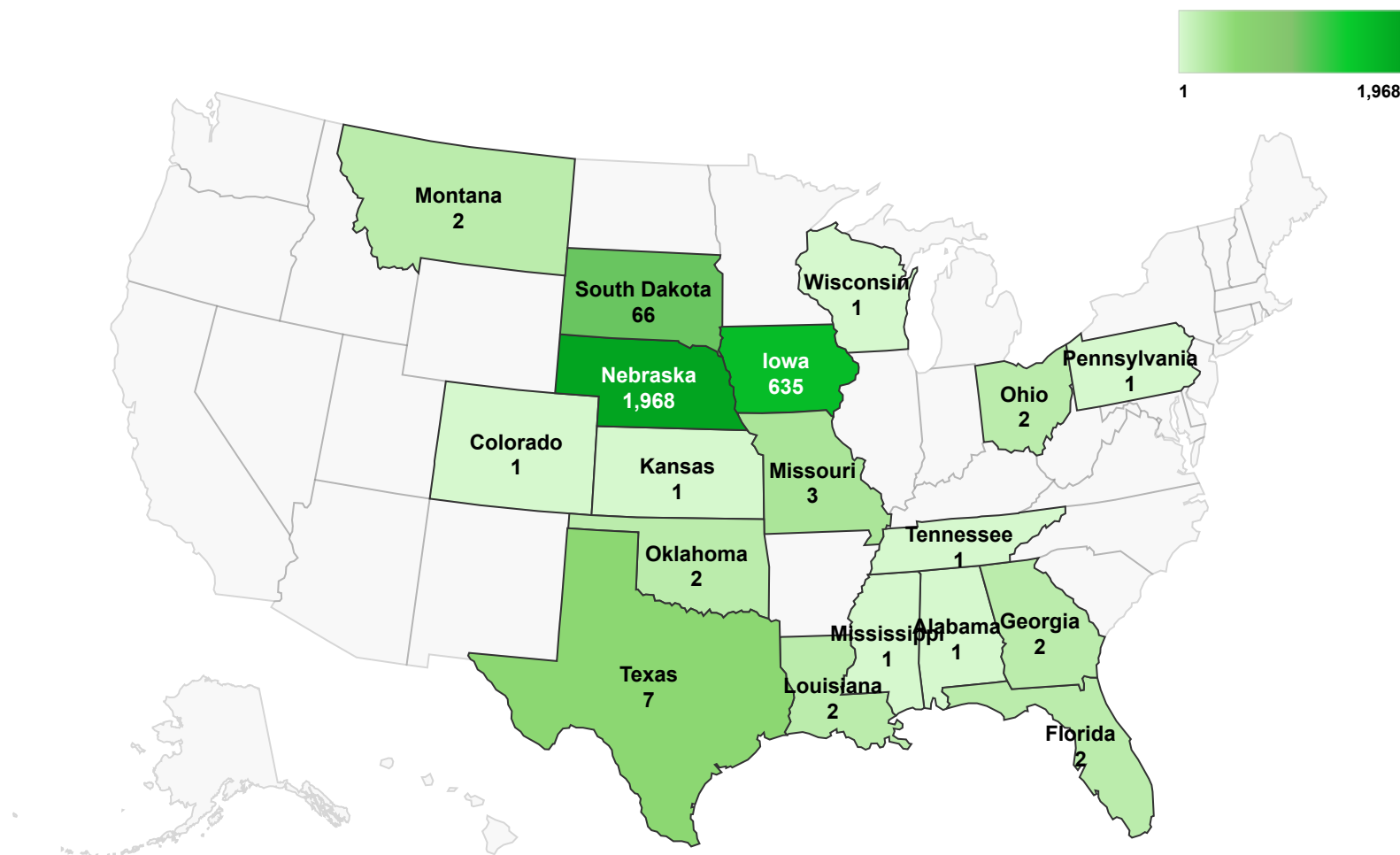

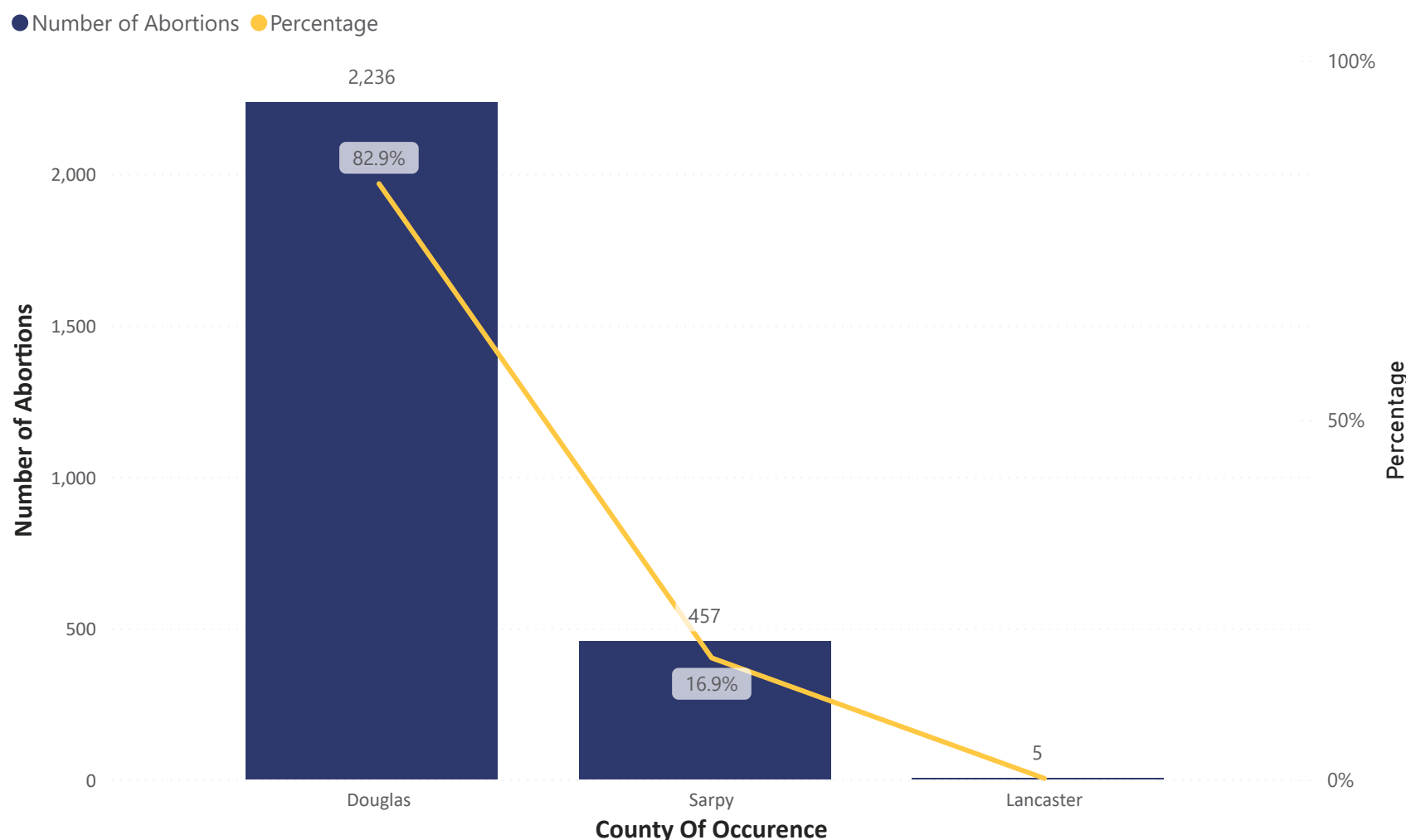

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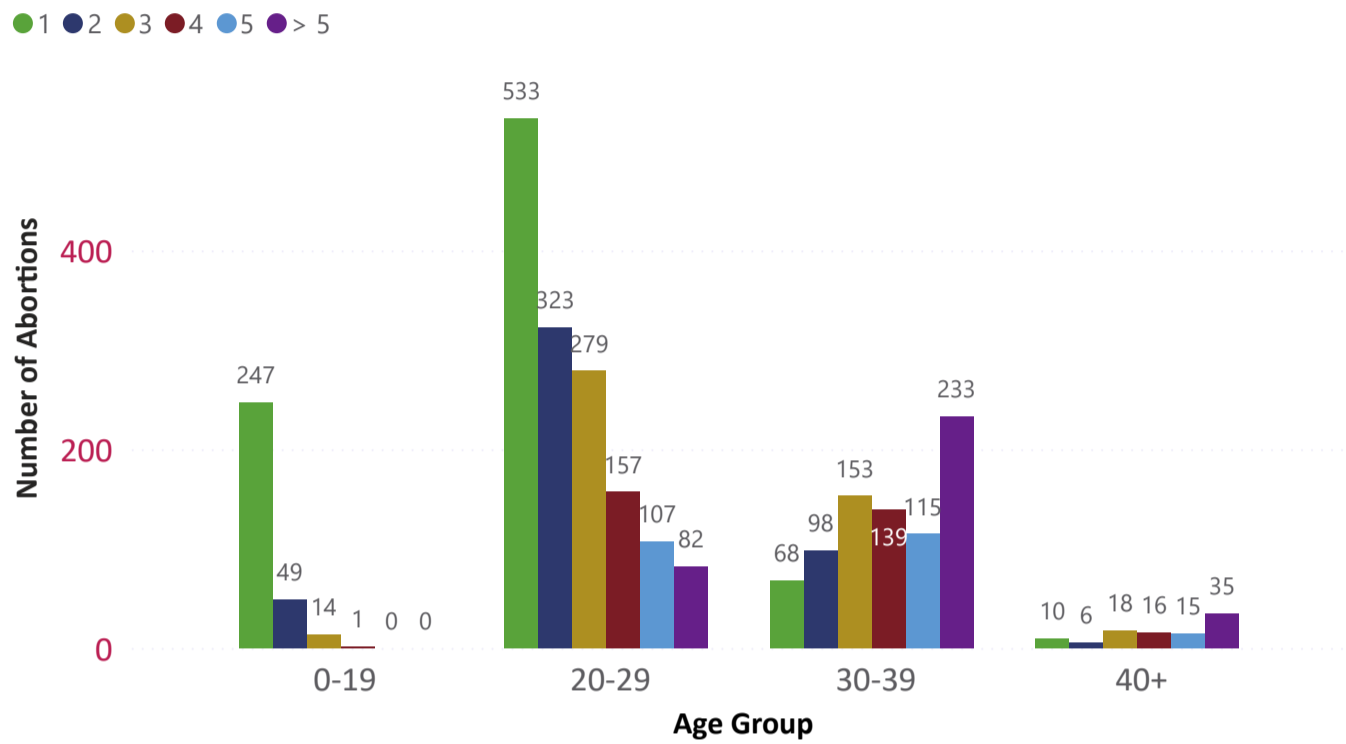

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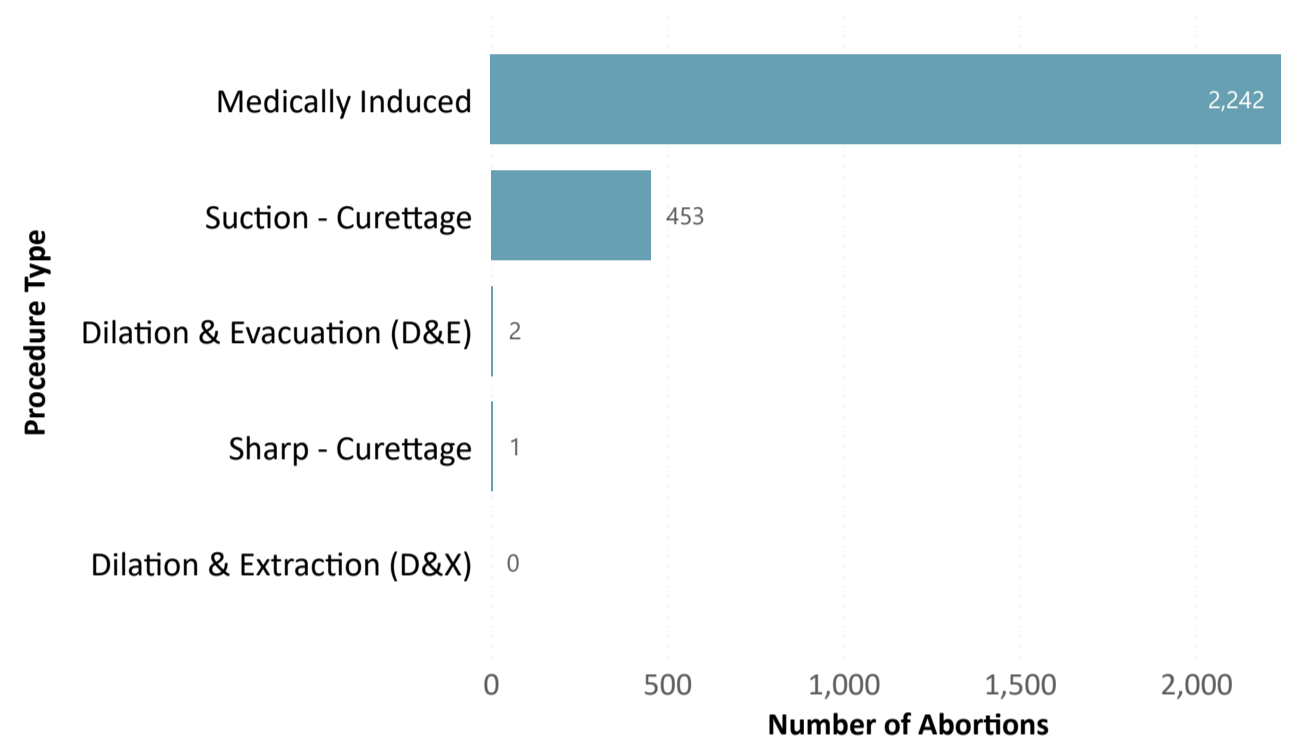

Number of Previous Pregnancies by Patient Age Group, Year: 2025



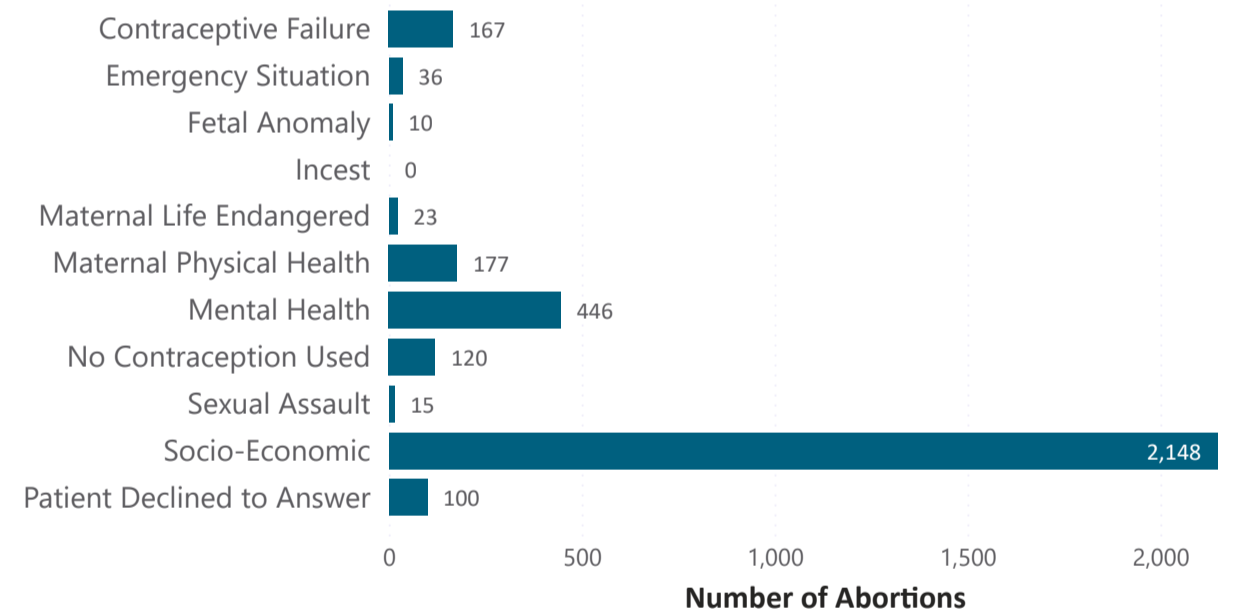

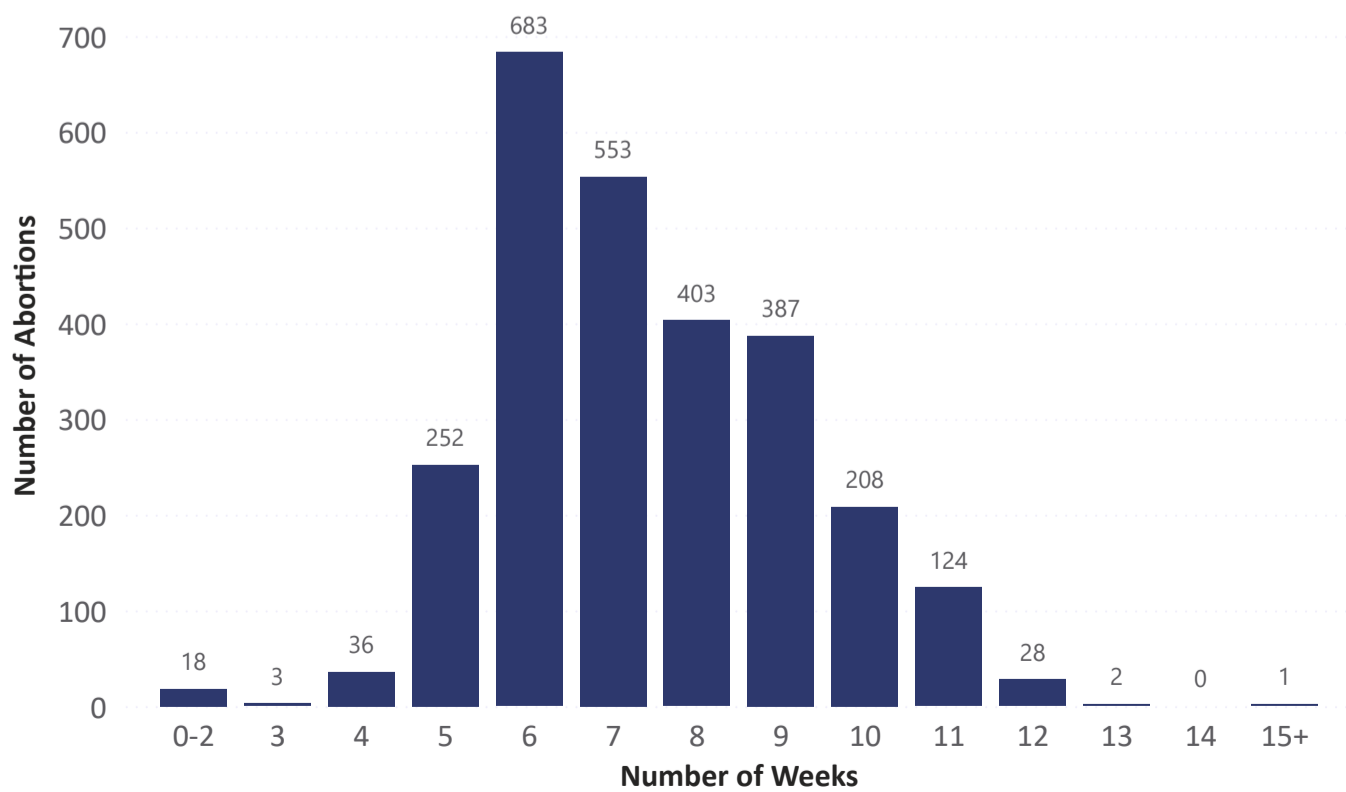

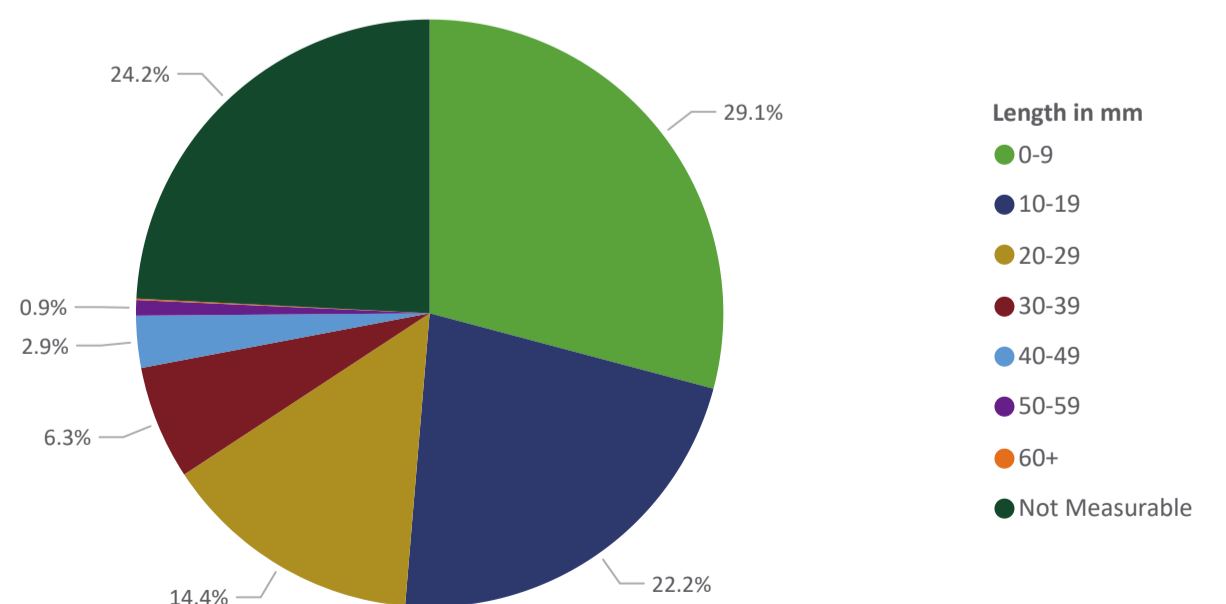
Number of Abortions by Reported Reasons for Abortions, Year: 2025

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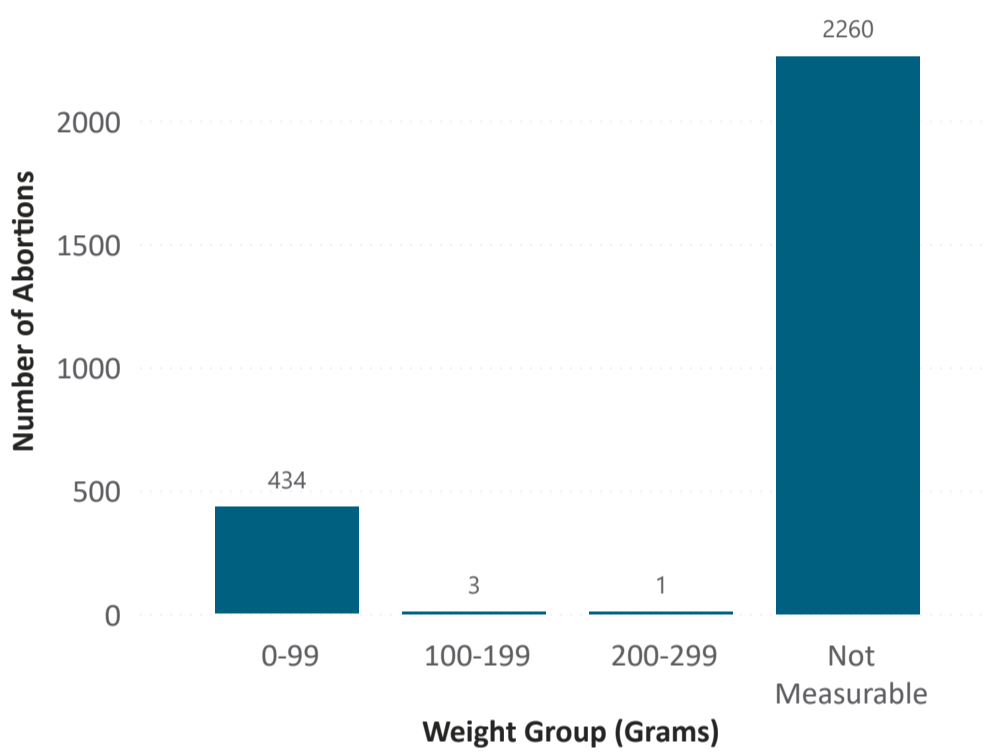

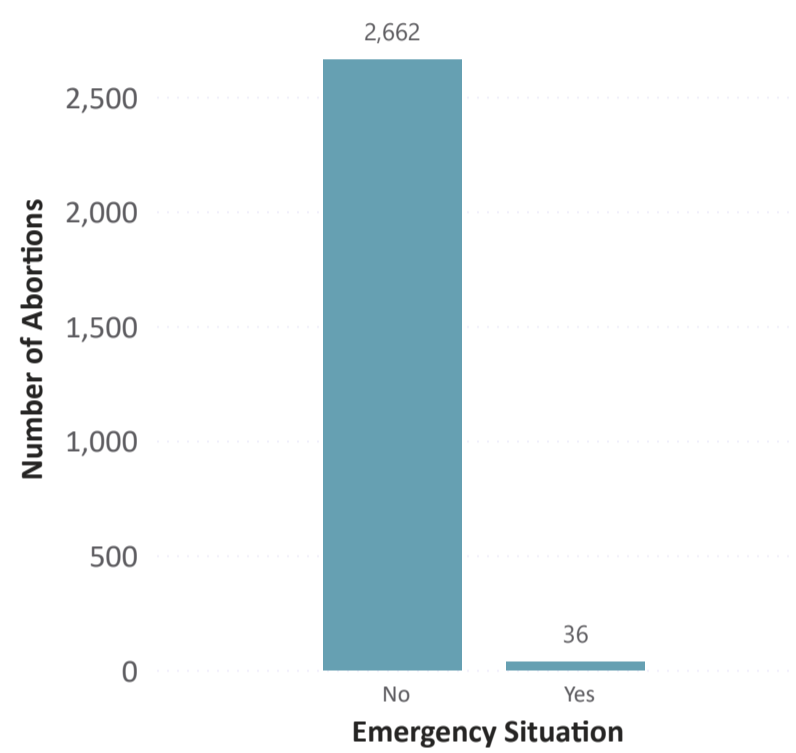

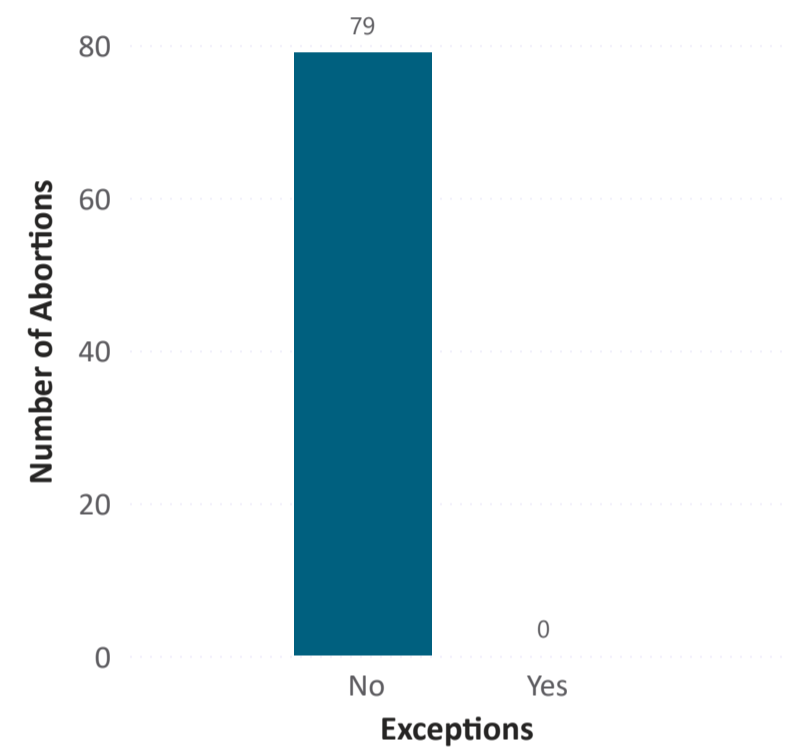
Number of Abortions based on Weight of Fetus, Year: 2025



Number of Emergency Situations, Year: 2025

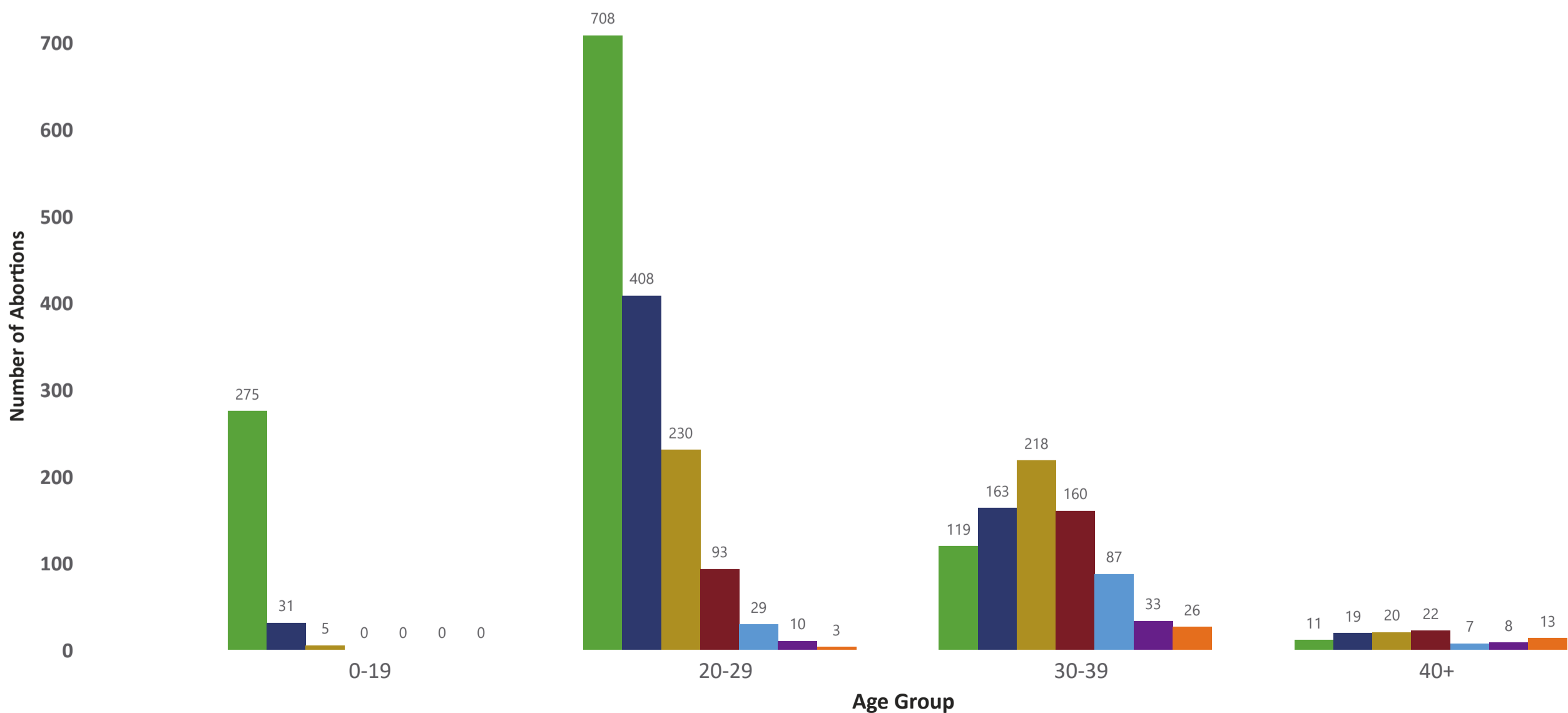


Number of Reported Exceptions, Year: 2025

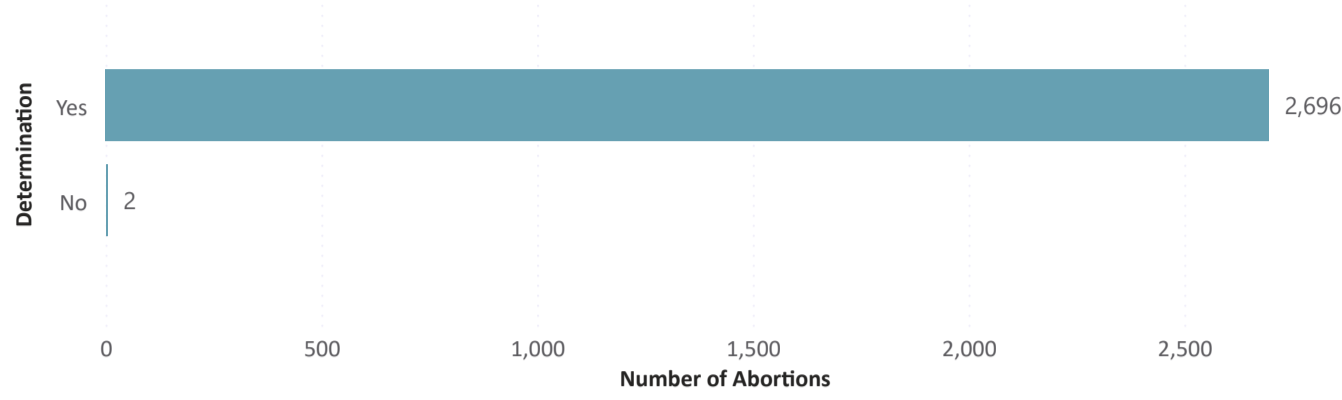

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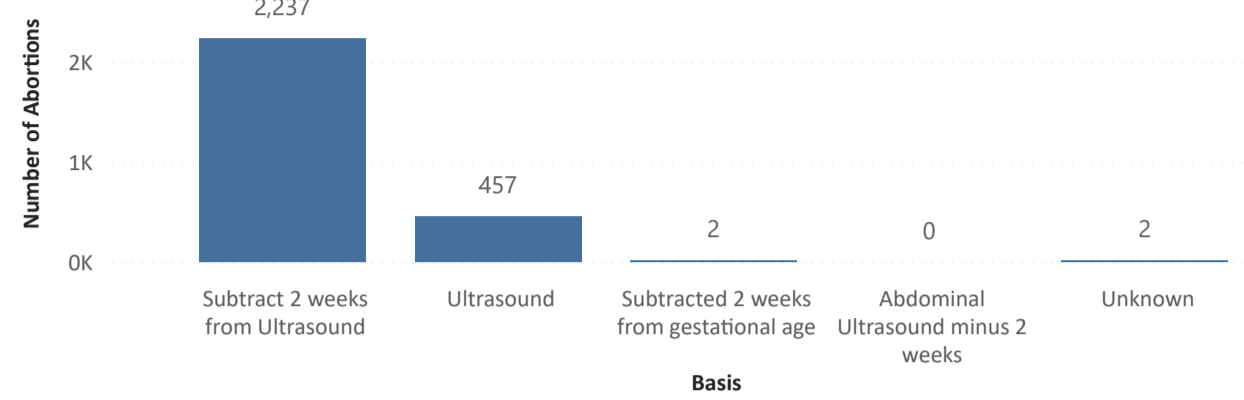

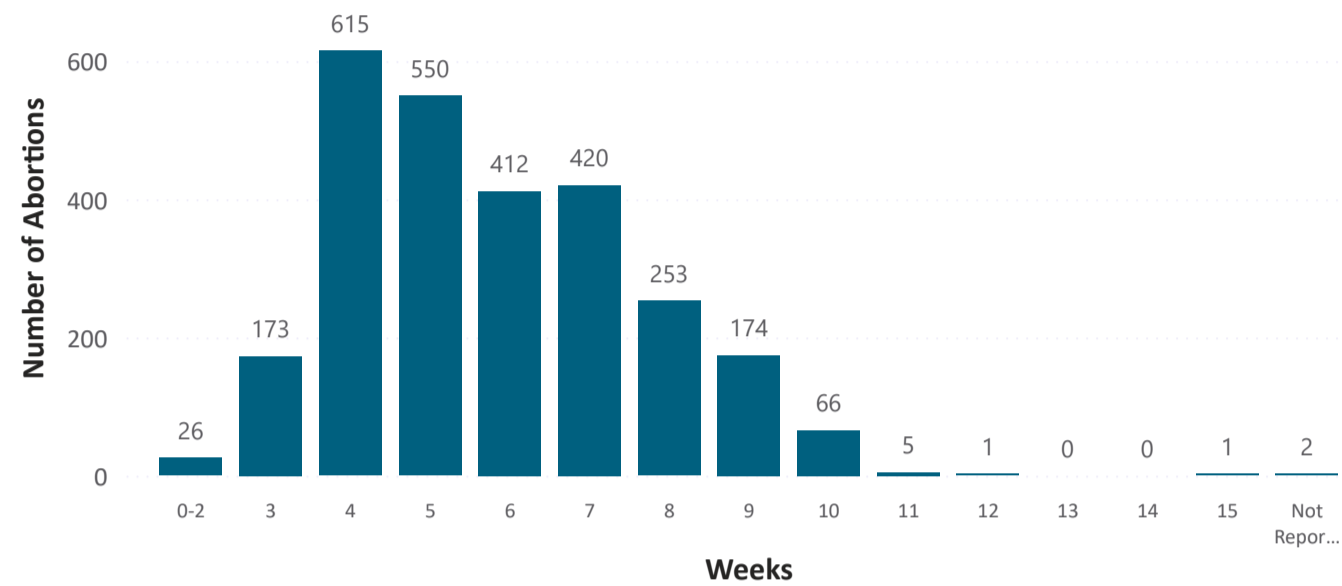

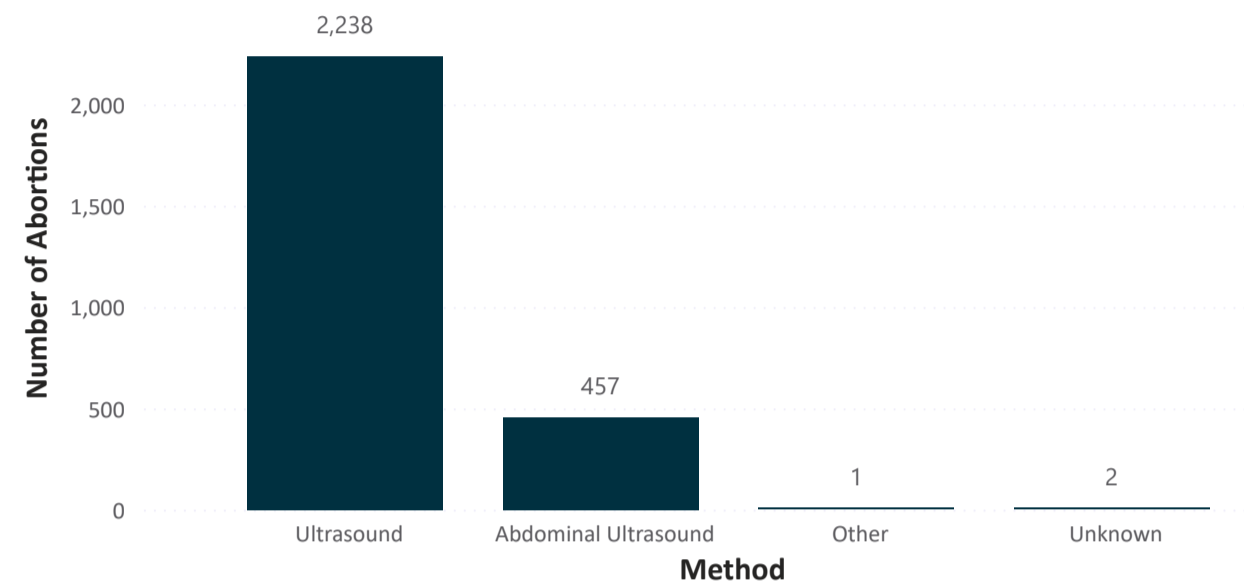
