

Women ages 21-34 can enroll into Every Woman Matters for Cervical Cancer Screening!

Beginning October 1, 2024, all women 21 and older will be enrolled into Every Woman Matters (EWM) for cervical cancer screening. You will no longer be able to enroll women into the State Pap Program.

What does this mean for you?

- ✓ Complete the NEW STI/STD Assistance Form for women and men needing assistance paying for an office visit to receive counseling and STI/STD testing.
 - The form can be found on the Provider Information Page https://dhhs.ne.gov/Pages/EWM-Provider-Information.aspx under the STI/STD Assistance (formerly State Pap Plus) tab.
 - Forms received between now and October 1, for State Pap clients 21+, will be automatically enrolled in EWM.
- ✓ The State Pap Program Enrollment form will no longer be accepted after October 1.
- ✓ Starting October 1, women 21-64 needing age appropriate screening services, need to fill out a Healthy Lifestyle Questionnaire (HLQ). (NEW HLQ COMING SOON!!)
- ✓ If State Pap Enrollment forms are received after October 1, they will be returned.

Eligibility criteria (Starting October 1) for <u>enrollment into EWM</u>:

- Must meet age guidelines. (21-64)
- Must not have health coverage that would pay for preventive screening services.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen or qualified alien under the federal Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq., as such act existed on January 1, 2009, and be lawfully present in the United States. (Permanent Resident Card/Green Card)
