So far in 2024, we have served 9,210 individuals who comprise 3,106 households from 51 communities in 27 Nebraska counties. Are we eligible to apply for these funds?	Organizations are eligible to apply if the nonprofit organization holds a certificate of exemption under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code that distributes food in ten or more counties in Nebraska and qualifies for the Emergency Food Assistance Program administered by the United States Department of Agriculture.

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3	2.3 Activities	6	I understand real property is not an eligible expense. My question is regarding tangible property such as vehicles, are they eligible?	The purchase of equipment or real property vehicles may be considered an allowable expense. Proposed expenses should be carefully detailed in the Applicant's budget narrative, providing sufficient information to assess the Applicant's compliance with cost principles, including a demonstration of the reasonableness of cost, proper allocability of costs to project activities, and plans for use and disposition.  Any purchase of equipment or real property with funds must align with the Uniform Guidance at 2 CFR Part 200 and should be acquired, used, maintained, and disposed of in full compliance with relevant laws and regulations.
