RE: Title 404 Regulations

The purpose of this bulletin is to notify developmental disabilities (DD) providers regarding the Department of Health and Human Services revision of Title 404 of the Nebraska Administrative Code (NAC). The regulations were approved through the hearing and adoption process and went into effect on November 19, 2022.

The changes identify insufficient or inconsistent language found within Title 404 NAC and align with updates to the Medicaid Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Developmental Disabilities Waiver applications approved by the Centers of Medicare and Medicaid Services.
