This bulletin is being issued to share with Nebraska Medicaid and CHIP providers additional information on relief funds from the Nebraska Department of Health & Human Services that are available through the CARES Act.

The Department of Health & Human Services is pleased to announce Round 2 of Community CARES grants for charitable organizations and providers. The Community CARES grants will help charitable organizations and certain provider organizations recover from and respond to the impacts of COVID-19. Resources for child care providers and centers of worship are also available.

Application deadline is November 13. Awards will be made on a first come, first served basis.
