Re: Pediatric COVID-19 Vaccinations

This provider bulletin is being issued to let providers know that reimbursement for the administration of COVID-19 vaccines has been broadened to include an additional age group.

Effective June 17, 2022, Nebraska Medicaid now covers COVID-19 vaccines for all beneficiaries who are at least 6 months old.

To obtain Medicaid reimbursement, COVID-19 vaccines must be provided according to the CDC guidelines.

Billing Instructions:

If administered in the pharmacy, use the NCPDP billing code to be reimbursed the administration fee.

If administered in the clinic or other non-pharmacy setting, use the CPT billing code.
