Re: Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) Season

This provider bulletin is being issued to notify Medicaid providers of an early start to the 2022//2023 Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) season as recognized by Nebraska Medicaid.

Typically, the RSV season in Nebraska begins in November and extends through March. Due to an early start of detected RSV activity, the RSV season as recognized by Nebraska Medicaid will begin October 1, 2022 for fee-for-service and managed care claims.

The existing prior authorization requirements for the prophylaxis of RSV, palivizumab (Synagis), remains the same. An approved prior authorization request will provide coverage for the Synagis series of five doses. A second prior authorization request will need to be submitted for additional doses of Synagis.

Nebraska Medicaid will continue to closely monitor RSV activity and will provide updated guidance on any ongoing management with Synagis prophylaxis when appropriate.
